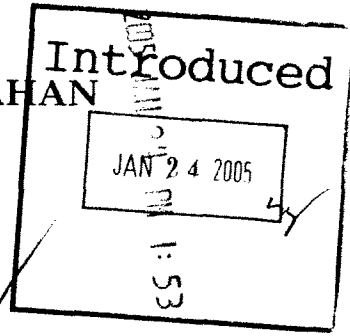


I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN

Relative to recognizing January 24 through 28, 2005, as "Guam Leadership Week" and January 28, 2005, as "Leadership Empowerment Day", in the interest of encouraging activities promoting excellence in leadership.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I
2 MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, the citizenry of Guam are a diverse and energetic people,
4 with many nations, vocations and a wide variety of religious, language and
5 ethnic traditions being represented; and

6 WHEREAS, this diverse citizenry prides itself on unity, by unifying
7 around the rule of law, community values and community goals, and also by
8 being purpose driven, unifying behind freely and democratically elected
9 leaders as well as those appointed leaders whose leadership is duly
10 authorized; and

11 WHEREAS, in recognition of the vital and indispensable role of
12 effective leadership in Guam's community affairs, "Empower Guam", a
13 ministry arm of St. Paul Assembly of God, is a non-profit, non-governmental
14 organization dedicated to fostering leadership on Guam in all walks of life,

1 petitioned *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*, the Governor of Guam, and *I Mina'Bente Ocho*
2 *Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the Twenty-Eighth Guam Legislature, to recognize the
3 week of January 24 through 28, 2005, as "Guam Leadership Week" setting
4 aside January 28, 2005, as "Leadership Empowerment Day" for appropriate
5 leadership recognition and empowerment activities to occur; and

6 **WHEREAS**, petitioners, as community members, desired a specified
7 opportunity to acknowledge and encourage island government leaders during
8 Guam Leadership Week, have offered to sponsor Guam's first annual
9 "Leadership Empowerment Breakfast" and to host Dr. John Hull, the
10 worldwide President of *Equip International*, as its featured speaker, awards
11 presenter and representative of the John Maxwell leadership organization
12 speaking on the topic, "TEAMWORK MAKES THE DREAM WORK FOR
13 SUCH A TIME AS THIS"; now, therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
16 people of Guam, recognize January 24 through 28, 2005, as "Guam Leadership
17 Week", and January 28, 2005, as "Leadership Empowerment Day"; and be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
20 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption
21 hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Reverend Jon

23 Reverend Steven McManus; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I*
24 *Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
