**Be it Resolved by *I Mina Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guahan*:**

**Whereas**, on March 14, 2006, the University of Guam ("the University"), a land grant institution, will observe its Charter Day, marking its founding; and

3 **Whereas**, the Territorial College of Guam, which was founded in 1952,  
4 offering limited classes at the old George Washington High School campus in  
5 Mongmong, was developed from a two-year teacher-training institution to a  
6 land grant university that offers a full range of undergraduate programs and  
7 graduate studies, relocated to its present one hundred (100) acre campus over-  
8 looking Pago Bay in Mangilao in 1961; and

9 **Whereas**, the Territorial College of Guam was renamed the "University of  
10 Guam" by the 9<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature after being accredited for the maximum  
11 period by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges ("WASC") in 1968;  
12 and

13 **Whereas**, the University of Guam's first Charter Day was proclaimed on  
14 December 17, 1968 by the Honorable Governor Manuel F.L. Guerrero through  
15 Executive Order 74-09; and

16 **Whereas**, while the University pursues its mission of providing resident  
17 instruction and research to the people of Guam, it also provides our neighbors  
18 throughout Micronesia the opportunity to achieve higher education; and

19 **Whereas**, the University of Guam, in its quest to maintain its tradition of  
20 excellence, continues to contribute to the Island's social, cultural, political and  
21 economic advancement; and

22 **Whereas**, the theme for this year "*Inina yan Sinaonao: Lini'e Todu I*  
23 *Tano*", ("**To Enlighten and Involve: Global Perspectives**") reflects the vision  
24 and revised mission of the University's governing Board of Regents and the  
25 President to provide higher education and opportunities for the people of Guam,  
26 the islands of the Western Pacific, and the Asian Pacific Rim nations; and

1           **Whereas**, the 2006 Charter Day activities will showcase Guam’s cultural,  
2 social, educational and recreational activities by inviting the people of Guam to  
3 visit the Mangilao campus during the week and share in these experiences; now  
4 therefore, be it

5           **Resolved**, that *I Mina Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on  
6 behalf of the people of Guam, join in the celebration of the University of Guam  
7 Charter Day and does commend the president, faculty, staff and students and  
8 Board of Regents in continuing to make this annual event a tradition; and be it  
9 further.

10          **Resolved**, that the Speaker certify to and the Legislative Secretary attest  
11 the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Ms.  
12 Sahara Defensor, President, UOG Student Government Association; to Dr.  
13 Harold L. Allen, President of the University; to Mr. Ronald Leach, Chairman of  
14 the UOG Board of Regents; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga Lahen*  
15 *Guåhan*.
