3 WHEREAS, the first "Doctor's Day" was held on March 30, 1933 by the

4 Barrow County Alliance in Winder, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the idea of setting aside a day to honor physicians was 6 conceived by Eudora Brown Almond, wife of Dr. Charles B. Almond; and

WHEREAS, "Doctors' Day" was established in commemoration of the
first administration of ether anesthesia by Dr. Crawford W. Long in 1842; and

9 WHEREAS, "Doctors' Day" is celebrated nationwide and is a day in 10 which physicians are recognized and honored for the profound role that they 11 perform in the well-being of their patients; and

WHEREAS, seventy-one (71) years ago, "Doctors' Day" was established
 on Guam in observance of physicians who have devoted their lives to the health
 and well-being of our Island community; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to improve patient care on Guam, the doctors at
the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) assiduously seek to upgrade
their skills and enhance their knowledge of the advances made in medical
science and technology; and

8 WHEREAS, representing twenty-nine (29) specialties and subspecialties, 9 the one hundred sixty-two (162) doctors of the GMHA spend countless hours in 10 multidisciplinary departmental and committee meetings in order to assist the 11 Hospital in attaining accreditation; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to enhance patient care services, the medical staff of the GMHA have been instrumental in the implementation of quality assurance and improvement plans at the Hospital, thus, providing clinical direction and leadership; and

16 WHEREAS, society owes a debt of gratitude to physicians for their 17 contributions in enlarging the reservoir of scientific knowledge, increasing the 18 number of scientific tools and expanding the ability of health professionals to 19 use the knowledge and tools effectively, in the name of medicine; and

WHEREAS, society owes a debt of gratitude to physicians for the sympathy and compassion of physicians in ministering to the sick and in alleviating human suffering; now therefore, be it
