



Relative to congratulating Fiesta Resort Guam on their Grand Opening Celebration marked for March 11, 2006.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'

WHEREAS, in March 17, 1971, Fiesta Resort Guam, formerly known as Guam Dai-Ichi Hotel, was the first high rise hotel on Guam and expanded with a new wing known as the Tower in 1986 to accommodate 337 guests and provide a chain of 11 food and beverage outlets; and

WHEREAS, in March 2002, Fiesta Resort Guam became the newest member of TanHoldings, a diverse holding company operating in 14 industries located in Guam, Saipan, Micronesia, Japan, and the Northern Mariana Islands; and

WHEREAS, Fiesta Resort Guam and Fiesta Resort and Spa Saipan are owned and operated by Asia Pacific Hotels, Inc., a subsidiary of TanHoldings

WHEREAS, in December 2005, the Fiesta Resort Guam 318 room resort and four food and beverage outlets underwent major renovations, designed
