RELATIVE TO COMMENDING THE SOLDIERS OF THE 1224TH ENGINEER DETACHMENT, GUAM ARMY NATIONAL GUARD, FOR THEIR HEROISM, DEDICATION TO OUR ISLAND AND OUR COUNTRY, AND SERVICE WHILE IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I MINA' BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, the 1224th Engineer Detachment ("the 1224th") is a unit of 54 of Guam's finest Soldiers in the Guam Army National Guard who have dedicated their lives to serving our country, to protecting our people and to standing up for freedom and justice throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th has spent the last year deployed in Afghanistan
in support of the Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and Marines in the Regional
Command East; and

10 WHEREAS, the 1224th supported more than 10 base camps in the 11 Regional Command East in Afghanistan, with improvements including 12 additional housing, force protection improvements, roads, landing zones, 13 airfields, plumbing and electrical work; and

1 WHEREAS, the unit was the tip of the spear in the building of two 2 expeditionary camps from the ground up to support democracy in 3 Afghanistan through the Afghanistan Parliamentary Elections, building two 4 fully functional camps in lass than a month's time equipped with billeting, 5 showers, burn-out latrines, force protection perimeter, guard towers and 6 bunkers; and

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WHEREAS, Forty-three (43) Soldiers in the unit were awarded the
Combat Action badge for being engaged by direct and indirect enemy fires at
various locations and times throughout the deployment; and

10 WHEREAS, the unit played a major role in the upgrade of the FOB 11 Salerno Airfield resulting in the emplacement of 650 feet of AM2 matting on 12 the runway touchdown points in just under five (5) days, allowing the 13 runway to remain open after major rain storms; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th managed a Five Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$500,000) heavy equipment contract that included over 20 pieces of rolling stock and over 25 local national employees; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th managed a Three Hundred Thousand Dollar
(\$300,000) concrete batching plant capable of producing over 300 cubic meters
of concrete per day; and

20 WHEREAS, the unit built Five (5) major culverts on FOB Salerno that 21 greatly improved the drainage problem that existed on the FOB; and

WHEREAS, the unit led the effort to construct the FOB Salerno Basic Load Ammunition Holding Area (BLAHA) that resulted in the movement of over Seventy Thousand (70,000) Cubic Yards of dirt and the creation of Fifteen (15) cells of store ammunition, resulting in a storage area that meets safety
 standoff; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th has displayed a dedication to duty and a bravery in combat and service that is worthy of recognition and honor from our country and our island; now, therefore be it

the people of Guam does hereby commend and honor the Soldiers of the
1224th Engineer Detachment for their valor, dedication and service to our
