Relative to commending the Republic of China (Taiwan) on its contributions to promote World Health and supporting the Republic of China's (Taiwan's) entry into the World Health Organization.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I
 MINA' BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, the preamble of the World Health Organization 4 ("WHO") Constitution recognizes that 'the enjoyment of the highest 5 attainable standard of health is one of the fundamental rights of every 6 human being without distinction of race, religion, political belief, economic 7 or social condition'; and

8 WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) and its twenty-three 9 million five hundred thousand (23,500,000) people wish to join the World 10 Health Organization as an observer; and

11 WHEREAS, because health and disease have no borders, it is in the 12 best interest of the advancing of human condition that the Republic of 13 China (Taiwan) be afforded membership in the WHO in order to benefit, 14 like all other members, from information in the prevention, monitoring and 15 cure of epidemic diseases, prevention of terrorist bio-chemical attacks, and 16 discussions of global health policies; and 1 WHEREAS, the Republic of China's (Taiwan's) achievements in the 2 field of health are substantial, which includes having one of the highest life 3 expectancy levels in Asia; maternal and infant mortality rates comparable 4 to those of western countries; the eradication of such infectious diseases as 5 cholera, smallpox and the plague; and the first to eradicate polio and 6 provide children with Hepatitis B vaccinations; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) has expressed a
willingness and possesses the ability to financially and technically assist
international health activities supported by the WHO; and

10 WHEREAS, in light of all the benefits that Taiwan's participation in 11 the WHO can bring to the state of health not only in Taiwan, but also 12 regionally and globally, Taiwan and its twenty-three million five hundred 13 thousand (23,500,000) people should have appropriate and meaningful 14 participation in the WHO; and

WHEREAS, the WHO Preamble further states that 'the health of all peoples is fundamental to the attainment of peace and security and is dependent upon the fullest cooperation of individuals and States', and therefore, direct, unobstructed participation in international health forums and programs is critical to limit the spread of various infectious diseases and achieve world health; now, therefore, be it
