
## I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2006 (SECOND) Regular Session

- 1 WHEREAS, over the past thirty-five (35) years; Genghis Khan
- 2 furniture has been the forefront of offering fine furnishings to
- 3 Island residents, the military families and businesses alike. Robert
- 4 and Anna Kao's loyal customers will attest to the quality
- 5 furnishings and services that Genghis Khan Furniture has offered
- 6 through the years. The Rosewood shop located in Andersen Air
- 7 Force Base has serviced the military for the past fifteen (15) years
- 8 and still continues to link military families to the main store off

- 9 Kao has supported local non-profit and profit organizations by
- participating as a member, donor or serving as Director for the
- 11 following: Sanctuar Inc., American Red Cross, Guma Mami, The

- 13 two term President for the Chinese School Foundation of Guam.

- 15 Commerce and serves on the Board Of Directors for Citizens

- gained would not have been possible without the commitment and
- support of Genghis Khan staff and management, in addition, the
- 20 strength of family, their children, Michael and Heidi along with
