WHEREAS, Master Sargeant Juan San Nicolas, born in May 1947 to Luis

WHEREAS, as the Guam National Guard celebrates its 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary
since its charter on July 21, 1981, Master Sgt. San Nicolas is one of only two
original charter members who is still active with the Guard; and

Master Sgt. San Nicolas is married to Oliva and the two of them have three
children - Tina, John and Tricia - and four grandchildren - Tiara, Mattua,
Tasi and Joffre; and

WHEREAS, in his 25 years of service to the National Guard, Master Sgt.
San Nicolas has provided outstanding contributions to the island of Guam,
through community service, the protection of the public and service oversees
fighting for our nation; and

WHEREAS, upon graduation from George Washington High School in
1966, he attended the Guam Community College and the College of Guam
now known as the University of Guam from 1966 to 1969 for Apprenticeship
Program for the Naval Ship Repair Facility; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from the Apprenticeship Program, he was drafted into the U.S. Army from April 22, 1970 – December 9, 1971 assigned to the C-Co 52 En Bn (Const) at Fort Carson, Colorado, whereupon he returned to SRF as an Apprentice Joiner and rose to the position of Wood Craftsman; and

WHEREAS, in the 1981 reduction-in-force as Construction Inspector
with OICC, he worked as Crater and Packer with Naval Air Station, Guam,
and later returned to SRF as a Shipwright, Training Leader, Production
Woodworker Shop Planner and Woodcrafter Foreman; and

WHEREAS, San Nicolas is a Civil Service retiree since May 31, 1994,
with a total of 28 years service with the Naval Ship Repair Facility

WHEREAS, San Nicolas was also assigned to the Civil Engineering Real
 Property and the 36th Security Force at Andersen Air Force Base, Guam and

had other temporary assignments in support of the South Pacific Games,
 COPE BUCS Exercise, Operations Pacific Haven, Aerospace Expeditory Force
 in Saudi Arabia as a Controller; and

 utilization as a hospital clinic; and

Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, his previous civic and community involvements include serving as a member of the Municipal Planning Council, member of the Holy Name Society of Jesus, member of the Guam Cursillo in Christianity, and he is currently a member of the Sergeants Association and was the Treasurer of the
