3           WHEREAS, Mr. Antonio P. Guerrero, is the husband of Cecilia T. Guerrero,  
4 and is the proud parent of five—Antonio, Dwayne, Christopher, Vincent and  
5 Vanessa, and grandparent of five; and

6           WHEREAS, Mr. Guerrero is an alumnus of the George Washington Senior  
7 High School Class of 1969, and an honorable retiree of the United States Air Force  
8 of 20 years; and

9           WHEREAS, in 1969, Mr. Guerrero began his public service career with the  
10 Government of Guam through Guam Memorial Hospital and resigned to enlist  
11 with the United States Armed Forces in 1970; and

12           WHEREAS, he resumed his employment as a public servant with the Guam  
13 International Airport Authority in 1991 and transferred to the Port Authority as a  
14 Security Guard (Armed) in May 28, 1991; and

1           WHEREAS, Mr. Guerrero was promoted to Port Police II in May 28, 1992  
2 and Port Police Supervisor in September 24, 2001; and

3           WHEREAS, while he was a supervisor, he was designated, on many  
4 occasions, to administer the Port Police Division's daily programs and activities in  
5 the absence of the Port Police Chief and

6           WHEREAS, Mr. Guerrero received awards for his dedication to the Port  
7 Authority of Guam, including the Supervisor of the Quarter Award for 2004,  
8 Supervisor of the Year in 2004, and a nominee for the 2005 Governor's MagHOPE  
9 Award of Excellence Program; and

10          WHEREAS, throughout his 23 years with the Government of Guam, Mr.  
11 Guerrero's outstanding performance and commitment have greatly contributed to  
12 the goals and mission of the Port; and

13          WHEREAS, while Mr. Guerrero was known to be "tough", other Port  
14 employees and the management respected him for being resourceful, devoted,  
15 efficient and a very dependable employee; now therefore be it

16          RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate  
18 Antonio P. Guerrero on his retirement from the Port Authority of Guam and  
19 commend and appreciate his many years of dedicated service to our country, our
