

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I* MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Down Syndrome is the most common congenital condition that affects one (1) in every seven hundred (700) to one thousand (1,000) children born each year; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services reports that, as recently as the past twenty (20) years, people with Down Syndrome were stigmatized or—all too frequently—institutionalized but are now benefiting from important advances in research, education, and health care; and

WHEREAS, children with Down Syndrome receiving parental love, nurturing and support as well as early intervention programs, such as educational opportunities and community involvement, are



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able to achieve their potential and function in society with a greater degree of independence; and

WHEREAS, with the vision and hard work of researchers, service-providers, physicians, teachers, parent support groups, and members of private and voluntary organizations, more people are now aware of the challenges of being an individual with Down Syndrome; and

WHEREAS, the Down Syndrome Association of Guam is working to improve the educational and vocational opportunities for individuals with Down Syndrome on the island of Guam; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize November 4, 2006 as 'Down Syndrome Awareness Day,' and urges the island community to actively participate in promoting greater understanding of Down Syndrome; and be it further

RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, commends practitioners who help raise awareness and support persons with Down Syndrome and their families and recognizes the significant contributions these individuals and organizations have made, and continue to make, in efforts to help

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persons with Down Syndrome lead active and productive lives; and be it further
