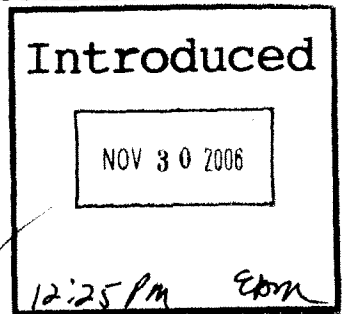

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN

3 WHEREAS, Miss Tiffany Joy Sarabia Huelar is the 16 year-old daughter
4 of Frank and Remy Huelar of Windward Hills; and

5 WHEREAS, Tiffany Joy is in her junior year at Southern High School;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, Miss Huelar has distinguished herself academically,
8 receiving the Presidential Award for Academic Excellence at Truman
9 Elementary School, earning recognition as Salutatorian of her graduating class
10 at Oceanview Middle School, and is currently attending high school Honors
11 level courses; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in civic affairs, Tiffany Joy placed her beauty, poise and
2 grace at the service of the Western Visayas College of Science and Technology
3 Alumni Association (Guam Chapter), on the occasion of the College's
4 centennial celebration in 2005, representing the Guam Chapter as their chosen
5 Centennial Queen during the Alumni Homecoming in July of that year; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Miss Huelar has been active in numerous other community
7 activities in the past year as well, including fundraising for Guam Community
8 College and WVCST scholarship programs, volunteer for Make-A-Wish,
9 Salvation Army and sports tournament events, active participant in
10 environmental and community facility cleanups, and as a library volunteer,
11 and hosting visiting Japanese students; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Tiffany Joy occupies herself in her free time with fun
13 activities that help mold her talents and build character in other ways, such as
14 piano lessons, and interscholastic volleyball and tennis; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Miss Huelar plans to continue her academic pursuits in
16 college upon graduation, to study biomedical engineering and medicine, and
17 return as a professional practitioner to her island home; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the National Honor Society was established by the National
19 Association of Secondary School Principals to create enthusiasm for
20 scholarship, to stimulate a desire to render service, to promote leadership, and
21 to develop character in secondary school students; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Southern High School Principal, National Honor
23 Society Chapter Adviser, and Faculty Council have examined the personal,
24 academic, and civic qualities of Miss Tiffany Joy Sarabia Huelar, and found

1 her to be an attractive candidate for membership in the National Honor
2 Society; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Miss Huelar has accepted such membership, and will be
4 installed at an Induction Ceremony to be held at Top O' the Mar at 6:00 P.M.
5 on Sunday, December 3, 2006; and
