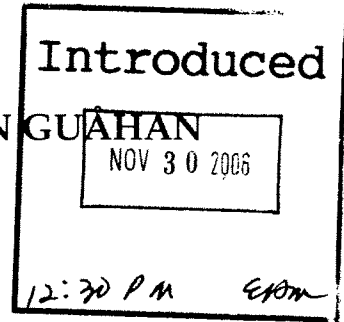

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN
2 GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, Master Henry Ray Torres Conway III is the 14 year-old son
4 of retired Sergeant Major Henry Rivera Conway and Eileen Torres Conway,
5 formerly of Yona and Yigo, now residing in Live Oak, Texas; and

6 WHEREAS, young Henry is a freshman at Judson High School, and a
7 member of the Judson Varsity Competitive Marching Band; and

8 WHEREAS, Henry Conway III is a member of Boy Scouts of America
9 Troop 512, Schertz, Texas, of the Alamo Area Council of San Antonio; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Henry was examined by an Eagle Scout Board of Review
2 on October 26, 2006, and found to have completed all leadership, service and
3 outdoor skills requirements of the Boy Scouts of America to be considered
4 worthy of advancement to the highest formal rank of achievement, namely,
5 Eagle Scout; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the rank of Eagle Scout is earned by about five per cent of
7 all Boy Scouts, conferred only upon those who demonstrate the highest levels
8 of citizenship training, character development, and personal fitness, as
9 determined by review processes in his scouting district, local and National
10 council levels; and

11 **WHEREAS**, attainment of Eagle Scout rank signifies great promise for
12 exemplary leadership in and service to every community where its bearer will
13 reside and work throughout his life; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Master Henry Ray T. Conway, III will be formally elevated
15 to the rank of Eagle Scout at an Eagle Court of Honor ceremony, to be
16 conducted in his honor on December 23, 2006 at VFW Post 8315 in Schertz,
17 Texas; and

18 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* wishes to publicly acknowledge
19 exemplary achievement by our youth, who, through individual determination
20 and support of family and caring adults, have demonstrated a lasting
21 commitment to constructive impact on the lives of people around him or her;
22 now, therefore be it

23 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby congratulates and
24 commends, on behalf of the People of Guam, Master Henry Ray Torres

1 Conway III on the occasion of his elevation to the rank of Eagle Scout; and be

4 commends Henry's parents and active leaders of Troop 512 for their effective
5 support and loving encouragement, that nurtured the development of Henry's
