3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas was born on May 7, 1955 and is
4 married to Antonio Posadas, with whom she has two (2) children: Christian and
5 Aubrey; and

6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas attended George Washington
7 Senior High in Mangilao, Guam from September 1971 to May 1973 and
8 subsequently received an Associates Degree from the University of Guam's School
9 of Nursing and Allied Health in 1975; and

10 WHEREAS, from September 1985 to May 1989, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-
11 Posadas attended the University of Guam and received a Bachelor of Science in
12 Nursing from the School of Nursing and Allied Health; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas received a Master of Nursing
14 from Washington State University, Intercollegiate College for Nursing Education
15 in July 1993; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas first obtained employment as a
2 Licensed Practical Nurse I at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority ('GMHA') in
3 1976 and eventually elevated to the position as Staff Nurse I in 1977; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas, throughout her distinguished
5 career, was employed in various positions at GMHA including Staff Nurse II, Staff
6 Nurse III, Associate Administrator of Clinical Services, Hospital Nurse Supervisor
7 II and most recently serving as Administrator of Hospital Nursing Services; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has also worked as a Staff Nurse
9 at Mission Bay Memorial Hospital and American River Hospital in California as
10 well as Staff Nurse at United States Naval Hospital and Community Health Nurse
11 I and II at the Department of Health and Human Services ('DPHSS') on Guam;
12 and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has served as an
14 Assistant/Clinical Instructor, Instructor, Assistant Professor and
15 Unit/Department Chairperson at the University of Guam's College of Nursing
16 and Health Sciences and as a Legislative Consultant for the Office of Senator Lou
17 Leon Guerrero during *I Mina' Bente Tres na Liheslaturan Guåhan*; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has held membership in various
19 professional organizations and committees, some of which are, the Guam Nurses
20 Association ('GNA'), where she served as President, the GNA Commission of
21 Nurse Leaders, the American Nurses Association, the GMHA Ethics Committee,
22 where she serves as Chairperson, and the GMHA Institutional Review Board; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas was the recipient of the DPHSS
24 Meritorious Award in 1988 and the World Health Organization ('WHO') and
25 DPHSS Fellowship Award in 1988. She was recognized as one of the Outstanding
26 Young Women of America in 1989 and for the President's List in 1989 and was a

1 nominee for the Who's Who in Nursing in 1991, GNA Nurse Educator Award in
2 1996 and GNA Nurse of the Year Award in 1997; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has served the government of
4 Guam and the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for a total of twenty-nine (29)
5 years and six (6) months, thus demonstrating her commitment to the health and
6 well-being of the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

7 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Bente Ocho na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
8 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-
9 Posadas for her contributions to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and to
