- 4 by local government officials in 1952 with the enactment of Public Law 67;

- 6 WHEREAS, the law implemented a travel industry on Guam; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the measure was passed by the First Guam Legislature and
- 8 signed into law by then Governor Carlton Skinner; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the territory blanketed with a security restriction on travel
- 10 imposed by the former naval administration caused plans for a travel industry
- 11 to come to a halt; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 1962 President John F. Kennedy lifted the security
- 13 restriction and Guam's tourism development would move closer to
- 14 realization; and
