3 **WHEREAS,** Guam's development of tourism was first acknowledged
4 by local government officials in 1952 with the enactment of Public Law 67;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS,** the law implemented a travel industry on Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS,** the measure was passed by the First Guam Legislature and
8 signed into law by then Governor Carlton Skinner; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the territory blanketed with a security restriction on travel
10 imposed by the former naval administration caused plans for a travel industry
11 to come to a halt; and

12 **WHEREAS,** in 1962 President John F. Kennedy lifted the security
13 restriction and Guam's tourism development would move closer to
14 realization; and
