- 3 WHEREAS, the Professional Support Division of the Guam
- 4 Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) is comprised of nine (9)
- 5 departments that include: Rehabilitative Services (Physical Therapy,
- 6 Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Recreational Therapy and Cardiac
- 7 Rehabilitation), Radiology (Mammography), Dietary (Food Care Facilities),
- 8 Respiratory Care, Pastoral Care, Pharmacy, Education, Laboratory, and
- 9 Social Services; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Rehabilitative Services is comprised of Physical
- 11 Therapists, Assistants and Aides, Occupational Therapists, Assistants and
- 12 Aides, Speech-Language Pathologists, Recreational Therapists and Aides,
- 13 and Cardiac rehabilitation Specialists, who provide services that help
- 14 restore function, improve mobility, relieve pain, and treat permanent

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1 physical, cognitive and emotional disabilities to people of all ages whose

2 lives have been affected by physical injury or illness, developmental

3 delays, or by the aging process; and

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WHEREAS, Mammography has been the only proven method to reliably detect tumors and show changes in the breast up to two (2) years before women may actually feel or suspect any changes, which ultimately contributes to the prevention and elimination of cancer or any other infectious disease that may occur in the breast; and

WHEREAS, Dieticians (in the Food Care Facilities) plan food and nutrition programs, supervise the preparation and serving of meals, and also help prevent and treat illnesses by promoting healthy eating habits and recommending dietary modifications; and

WHEREAS, the Respiratory Therapy Department provides quality care to patients of all ages by treating all respiratory problems, including activities involving diagnosis, therapeutics, administration, and education. Therapy may include aerosolized breathing treatments, ventilator management, oxygen therapy and postural drainage to help clear the lungs; and

WHEREAS, the Respiratory Department provides diagnostic testing to patients, while therapists are also involved in educating the patients and their families about the treatment of respiratory problems and preventive care; and

WHEREAS, the Pastoral Care Department centers on the presence of a Supreme Being, and the human dignity of the individual patient, family, and staff in achieving holistic healing, and ministering to their spiritual 1 needs with respect, care, and compassion, being sensitive also to their

2 psychological, emotional, and social needs; and

WHEREAS, Pharmacists are licensed and well-educated individuals who carry the task of dispensing drugs prescribed by physicians, while also advising physicians on the selection of medicine, and then monitoring the health and progress of patients in response to their drug therapy; and

WHEREAS, the Education Department is responsible for coordinating continuing education to all staff of the hospital and the medical community, including physicians, nurses, and allied health professionals to ensure the highest quality of competency and knowledge in providing patient care services; and

WHEREAS, Medical Laboratory Science has advanced laboratory professionals to become indispensable members of the healthcare team involved in medical diagnosis, management, surveillance and research; and

WHEREAS, Medical Laboratory professionals have made significant contributions to the improvement of our island's healthcare and living standards; and

WHEREAS, Social Services provides discharge planning to acute inpatients, networking and collaborating with agencies and community services, providing crisis intervention, and addressing the medical and financial needs of its clients to assume high quality and continuity of healthcare; and

WHEREAS, each of the aforementioned departments equally contribute to meeting the needs of their patients, while attempting to make
