
1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN

WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization began seventeen years ago in May of 1988, continues to strive through effective leadership, enthusiasm, dedication and commitment of its members and our island's youth every year. They are a team of individuals working together by sharing ideas and responsibilities in order to accomplish their programs and community prevention activities; and

9 WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization, which is a non-profit 10 community-based substance abuse prevention program for youths between 11 the ages of eleven to seventeen and the organizations main focus is to train 12 our youths as drug prevention practitioners; and

. ¶ WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization, for the last fifteen years, holds the Annual Youth for Youth Conference which caters to approximately four hundred middle and high school student teams and are recruited primarily as participants for this particular conference; Local middle and high school students undergo a year round prevention training and serve as members of the Annual Youth Conference Planning Committee; and

7 WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization, for the last ten years 8 organized the Summer Swim and Water Safety Program for over two 9 hundred children between the ages of five to fifteen years old and focuses on 10 utilizing trained youth leaders as program staff and workshop facilitators 11 during this six week program. The children are taught how to swim, about 12 water safety, and the facts about substance abuse prevention, developing 13 communications and problem skills, building self-esteem and having fun 14 without the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs; and

15 WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization, which organized the 16 Annual National Red Ribbon Week, is a grassroots Substance Abuse 17 Awareness effort to reduce demand of illegal drugs and promote prevention 18 and education programs for elementary, middle and high school students and 19 the Community-at-large; and

WHEREAS, the Youth for Youth Organization, which organized the Annual National Kick Butts Day is a day when thousands of children stand up against tobacco addiction and the adults stand up for the children. The Kick Butts Day is a worldwide activity and takes place in all fifty states and even across the globe; and be it further
