

- 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I*
2 *MINA' BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:
- 3 WHEREAS, Roger Lee Cauley was born on February 6, 1955; and
4 WHEREAS, Roger married Elizabeth and had one son, Brian; and
5 WHEREAS, Roger graduated from Owensboro (KY) School of
6 Practical Nursing in 1974; and
7 WHEREAS, Roger received his Associates Degree in Applied Science
8 from Madisonville (KY) Community College in 1977; and
9 WHEREAS, Roger served as Head Nurse at Owensboro Daviess
10 County Hospital in Kentucky from 1977-1978; and
11 WHEREAS, Roger, while serving as Charge Nurse at St. Louis
12 University Hospital from 1978-1980, earned his Bachelors Degree in
13 Nursing from St. Louis University in 1980; and
14 WHEREAS, from 1980-1982, Roger was the Primary Health Care
15 Instructor/Coordinator and Liaison Officer for the American Peace Corps

1 Volunteer in Yemen and, from 1982-1984, he served as the Nursing
2 Supervisor at Al-Salam Hospital, also in Yemen; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Roger was the Director of Continuing Education at
4 Owensboro Daviess County Hospital and a Registered Nurse at Ohio
5 County Hospital, both in Kentucky, from 1985-1987; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Roger served the people of Guam as a Staff Nurse from
7 1984-1985 and Nurse Supervisor from 1987-2005 at the Guam Memorial
8 Hospital, Nursing Supervisor for the FHP Clinic in 1987, and an
9 Emergency Medical Services Instructor at the Guam Community College
10 from 1992-2005, while also obtaining his Masters Degree in Public
11 Administration for the University of Guam in 1995; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Roger was co-owner of Marianas Home Care from 1995
13 until his passing, Guam Nursing Services and Therasource International
14 from 1995-2004, and eventual owner of Guam Nursing Services and
15 Marianas Health Services, Inc., an affiliated company in Saipan, from 2004
16 until his passing; and

17 **WHEREAS**, in acknowledgment of his contributions in the area of
18 health care nationally, internationally, and locally, Roger was recognized
19 with the United States Presidential Award for Exceptional Services as an
20 American Peace Corps Volunteer in 1982, recognized with a resolution
21 from *I Mina' Bente Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* for his outstanding
22 contribution in the field of American Nursing and to the island of Guam,
23 and recognized in the *Who's Who in American Nursing* in 1991; and

1 WHEREAS, the people of Guam appreciate and are grateful for the
2 contributions Roger made to health care on Guam and worldwide; now
3 therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina' Bente Ocho na*
5 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan* and the
6 people of Guam, recognize the contributions of the late Roger Lee Cauley
7 and extend condolences to his family on his passing; and be it further
