WHEREAS, Dr. Arnold T. Salud, an Ophthalmologist at the American Eye Center and an active consultant at The Medical City and The Manila Doctors Hospital in the Philippines, has graciously accepted the invitation from the Guam Diabetes Association to be a professional presenter in the 2005 Diabetes Conference on Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Salud completed his post-graduate course in medicine in 1992 and his residency in Ophthalmology in 1996 at the University of the Philippines-Philippine General Hospital (UP-PGH); and

7 in various clinical cases which have accorded him the opportunity to impart his
8 experience through various lectures on diabetic retinopathy and the pathology of
9 retina and vitreous; and

11 phototherapeutic keratectomy, malignant orbital schwannoma in a child, and macular
12 hole surgery among numerous other publications; and

14 keeping abreast with the evolving techniques and technology in ophthalmology by
15 actively attending different scientific meetings including the American Academy of
