9 was assigned to the Syracuse SkyChiefs, Toronto's Triple A affiliate; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in August of 2006, John Hattig, Jr. was promoted to the  
11 major leagues and is expected to join the Toronto Blue Jays. John's most recent  
12 accomplishment is a testament to his immeasurable hard work and  
13 unyielding determination to achieve his dream; and


14 **WHEREAS**, John's success story, speaks to the discipline, respect, and

21 Guam's youth and as a proud son of Guam; and be it further


22 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
