1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**
2 ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero was born and
4 raised in the village of Barrigada. He joined the Guam Army National Guard
5 on June 10th 1982 and completed Basic Training at Fort McClellan, Alabama.
6 He was a member of the 731st Military Police, Enemy Prisoners of War (EPW)

1 Processing Unit, the first Guam National Guard Unit to be deployed in
2 support of Desert Shield, Desert Storm on December 1991; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1992, the 731st Military Police Company was deactivated
4 and Sergeant Major Leon Guerrero transferred over to the 1/294th, Infantry
5 Battalion. Sergeant Major Leon Guerrero's assignments included: Platoon
6 Sergeant, 731st Military Police Co. 800th Military Police Brigade, Saudi Arabia;
7 First Sergeant, Bravo Co. 1/294th Infantry Battalion; First Sergeant, Guam Area
8 Command, Operations SGM POMSO, Commandant 203rd Regional Training
9 Institute and Operations SGM 105th Troop Command; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Major Leon Guerrero's military schools included
11 Basic Non-Commissioned Officers Course, Advance Non-Commissioned
12 Course, Instructor Training Course, First Sergeant Course and the Sergeant
13 Majors Course. His civilian schools include the Guam Police Academy, FBI
14 First Line Supervisor Course, a graduate of the Asia Security Studies, and the
15 Comprehensive Security Response to Terrorism, Executive Course at the Asia
16 Pacific Center of Security Studies, Fort Dorusey, Hawaii. Sergeant Major Leon
17 Guerrero holds a Baccalaureate Degree on Criminal Justice Administration
18 from the University of Guam; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in his civilian occupation, Sergeant Major Leon Guerrero is
20 a Police Officer with the Guam Police Department and currently holds the
21 rank of a Police Major. He oversees the Neighborhood Patrol Division,
22 Criminal Investigation Division, Guam Highway Patrol Division, Forensic
23 Science Division and Special Operations Command which includes the SWAT
24 Unit, and the Governor' Security Unit. He is also designated as the Police

1 Department "Incident Commander" and manages the Department's resources
2 during emergency crisis; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Major Leon Guerrero is married to Janet Leon
4 Guerrero, for twenty-eight (28) years. Together, they have four (4) children,
5 Mardie, Ricky, Janalyn and Janessa (twins). They are blessed with seven (7)
6 grandchildren; now, therefore, be it


7 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
