3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz, better known as "Ike," with the**
4 **support of his loving wife Rose and three (3) children, Sandra, Francine,**

1 Robert, and grandson Anthony, will retire from the Government of Guam
2 after twenty-five (25) years of dedicated service; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz has worked for the Government of
4 Guam since November 5, 1984, when he began his public service career as an
5 Auxiliary Worker with the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), on
6 January 27, 1985, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz earned a Probationary appointment as a
7 Utility Worker with the department; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on March 4, 1986, Mr. Ignacio Cruz was sworn in as an
9 Enforcement Officer for DPR; and on July 3, 1988, he was promoted to the
10 position of Grounds Maintenance Supervisor; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz was awarded a number of
12 commendations for his service, dedication and performance; and

13 **WHEREAS**, on July 5, 1989, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz was lauded for his
14 preparation of the Veterans Cemetery for Veterans Day; he received a Letter
15 of Commendation from the Honorable Carl T. C. Gutierrez, former Governor
16 of Guam, for his labor in the aftermath of Typhoon Dale; and received Letters
17 of Appreciation for his work during the Earth Week Cleanup in 1997 and the
18 First Lady's Annual Halloween Activities in 1999, among other recognition;

20 **WHEREAS**, in addition, to his work with the Department of Parks and
21 Recreation, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz participated in various training sessions and
22 workshops to enhance his skills and proficiency: he attended the
23 Comprehensive Safety Training Course for Managers and Supervisors on
24 February 28, 1990; Training for Personal Protective Equipment on February
25 28, 1991; Fall Protection Training on June 19, 1998; and Completion of the

1 Incident Response to Terrorist Bombing Awareness Training on March 22,
2 2004; and


3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ignacio Q. Cruz has proven himself to be an invaluable

11 Division of the Department of Parks and Recreation; and be it further


12 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
