11 has been an active member of the Guam Chinese Women’s Organization and
12 the Guam International Women’s Organization; and

13 **WHEREAS**, she has unselfishly contributed her time and efforts to
14 worthy causes, helping to raise funds for the Guam Chapter of the American
15 Red Cross and the Make-A-Wish Foundation; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in the past seven (7) years, she has faithfully volunteered
17 her time in various community projects such as Operation Christmas Drop,
18 the Guam Chamber of Commerce Skinner Plaza Festival, the First Lady’s

3 by the community; now, therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
