Relative to commending Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano, United States Air Force, on his highly successful tour of duty on Guam, and particularly for his efforts to promote a better relationship between the United States Air Force and the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I***
2 ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano, a career NCO who came to**
4 **Andersen Air Force Base, Guam in February 2005, has given unselfishly in**
5 **promoting friendship and cultural awareness between the United States Air**
6 **Force and the people of Guam, and has had an outstanding tour of duty in**

1 Guam, where his presence will be surely missed by friends in the military as
2 well as the civilian community; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano, a Customer Support
4 Controller from California, was assigned as Lead Operations Management
5 Journeyman, 36th Civil Engineer Squadron and has shown deep compassion
6 for the people of Guam by his efforts in supporting Guam's HASSO program.
7 His selfless dedication has helped keep Guam's coastal areas in their beautiful
8 natural condition. Furthermore, his efforts ensured better living conditions
9 for animals when he led twelve (12) airmen in a total Guam Animals in need
10 makeover, turning a jungle into a paradise and spending many hours cleaning
11 kennels, feeding animals, cutting grass, and repairing fences. He also aided in
12 providing schools with computer equipment through the ADPE program by
13 collecting computers, monitors, printers, and computer hardware. He has
14 also volunteered to be a part of the International Christian Assembly music
15 team as a musician; and

16 **WHEREAS**, he was a catalyst for Andersen AFB/Guam Community
17 relations; he manned water stations for Guam's First Annual Koko Race,
18 supporting over a thousand runners which improved Guam's tourism. He
19 was also an active booster club member, volunteering a total of forty (40)
20 hours for two (2) consecutive years as a tour guide for the 2nd and 3rd Annual
21 CE haunted house, which raised a total of Three thousand Dollars (\$3,000) for
22 squadron morale activities. As a proactive Air Force Sergeants Association
23 member, he helped raise One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) by assisting with gift
24 wrap activities; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano was a champion of support
2 to Team Andersen’s quality of life; he maintained one thousand eight
3 hundred sixty (1,860) facilities, comprising 6.9 million sq. ft. throughout
4 fifteen (15) geographical sites; processed over nine thousand (9,000) AF Forms
5 and three hundred thirty two (332) work orders for consideration at the
6 weekly Work Request Review Board (WRRB). He managed seventy eight (78)
7 in-house work orders valued at Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200K) for
8 the newly established TOP thirty six (36) Program; ensured equal balance
9 among group monitors for three hundred thirty two (332) improved facilities
10 base-wide. He effortlessly processed four thousand five hundred (4,500)
11 direct scheduled work orders valued at Five Million Dollars (5,000,000.00)
12 which increased longevity of base facilities. He superbly managed the
13 digging permit program, which resulted in zero project delays experienced for
14 fifty plus (50+) in-house/contracted tasking. He ensured shop cooperation for
15 repair of twenty plus (20+) power outages and water breaks which minimized
16 down time on base; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano managed Six Hundred
18 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$620,000) in wireless communication assets;
19 created on inventory process and assisted in LMR upgrade, and migration
20 created squadron network security posture boosted thirty percent (30%). He
21 diagnosed a system problem with civil engineer radio feeder; initiated
22 immediate repairs which resulted in no communication downtime. He
23 oversaw/processed over two thousand (2,000) work requests monthly, and
24 swift project execution reduced approval process by fifty percent (50%). He
25 diligently monitored the EOY labor summary file for cost accounting

1 variations and ensured historical data was error-free. He organized weekly
2 schedulers meetings for the 36th Civil Engineer Squadron and provided
3 leaders with a real-time view of over seven hundred (700) work orders. He
4 established a new tracking system for AF Form three-hundred thirty two (332)
5 inputs; and ensured positive control of work order packages. He scrubbed
6 four hundred (400) work orders and closed outdated work requests, which
7 reduced backlog by fifty percent (50%) and saved two hundred fifty (250) man
8 hours in twelve (12) shops. He inventoried five (5) Damage Control Center
9 (DCC) ADPE systems/two deployment kits and ensured one hundred percent
10 (100%) accuracy. He is an outstanding scholar who actively pursued CCAF in
11 Operations Management through the University of Maryland; accrued a total
12 of sixty one (61) credit hours with a 3.7 GPA. He was recognized by his
13 supervisors for his outstanding performance and awarded the "Airman of the
14 Quarter" for October to December 2005; and


15 **WHEREAS**, Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano meticulously prepared shop
16 safety and training logs for Unit Compliance Inspection, vital to the
17 squadron's "Excellent" rating. His efforts aided in capturing the Pacific Air
18 Forces' Outstanding Civil Engineer Unit Award small unit category, two
19 times in a row. His skillful planning and control of work order projects led to
20 thirty six (36) CES "Best CE Small Unit" in PACAF for 2005 and 2006; now,
21 therefore, be it

23 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the
24 people of Guam, commend and express deep gratitude to Staff Sergeant Don
25 D. Adriano, United States Air Force, for his many contributions to the people


1 of Guam, and we salute him for outstanding duty and particularly in his
