1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS, Mrs. Roberta "Bobbie" Sayama Balajadia started her career**  
4        **as a temporary substitute Distribution Clerk at the Barrigada Post Office in**  
5        **1970. Her position was changed to part-time flexible Distribution Clerk in**

1 1971 and in 1973, was converted to full-time Distribution Clerk and  
2 reassigned to Distribution, Window and Markup Clerk; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1974, Mrs. Roberta Sayama Balajadia was reassigned  
4 back to Distribution Clerk. In 1981, she was promoted to Superintendent,  
5 Window Services (B) and in 1993, was reassigned to her present position of  
6 Supervisor, Customer Services; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in the past, Mrs. Roberta Sayama Balajadia was recognized  
8 for her work performance with an EAS Spot Award. This Award recognized  
9 Roberta's continuous exemplary performance, which was considered over  
10 and above normal. She has consistently displayed an excellent attitude and  
11 exceptional proficiency, and worked diligently to completing her assignments;

13 **WHEREAS**, one of the EAS Recognition Awards Citation read: "Mrs.  
14 Balajadia has discreetly assisted in investigation where confidentiality was  
15 essential. Mrs. Balajadia has been resourceful in addressing inspection service  
16 requests, and was always gracefully assisted when tasked by this agency with  
17 additional responsibilities which extend beyond her own area of  
18 responsibility. Mrs. Balajadia's contribution to the Guam Inspection Service  
19 domicile contributed to the effectiveness and efficiency with which Inspector  
20 Cunicelli accomplished his mission"; and

21 **WHEREAS**, aside from duties and responsibilities with the Postal  
22 Service, Roberta was very active with the St. Francis Parent Teachers  
23 Association and the St. Francis Parish Council. As a member of the Parish  
24 Council, Roberta served as the Social Committee Chairperson from 1990 to  
25 1992. She also found time to serve as a member of the Board of Directors for

1 the Naval Marianas Federal Credit Union and with the Postal Service where  
2 she served as a member of the Moral, Welfare, Recreation Committee from  
3 2003 to 2004; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout her career with the Postal Service, Roberta has  
5 been blessed with a wonderful, caring and understanding family led by her  
6 husband Enrique P. Balajadia, their five (5) children and twelve (12)  
7 grandchildren and have built a reputation on honesty, loyalty and  
8 dependability; now, therefore, be it

10 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the
