4 commemorate the end of Imperial Manchu Qing Dynasty Rule, the
5 establishment of the Republic of China under the leadership of Dr. Sun yat-
6 Sen, and the beginning of the system of democracy enjoyed by the people of
7 the Republic today; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam, along with the people of Taipei City,
9 have shared a special Sister-City bond that has benefited the people of Guam
10 through its cultural exchanges and economic investments since 1973; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam are grateful for the strong Sister-City
12 relationship with Taipei, a decade long relationship of cultural and economic
13 exchange that has greatly benefited our island; and

14 **WHEREAS**, tens of thousands of people from Taiwan visit our island
15 every year, fostering the growth of our primary industry, tourism; and


16 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam greatly value the many contributions
17 to our island from members of our Chinese Community who continue to be at
18 the heart of various community projects throughout our island under the
19 United Chinese Association of Guam, the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of

4 of its Ninety-sixth (96th) 'Double-Tenth National Day'; and be it further


5 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does

19 in Guam; to Mr. Joseph Hsu, President of the United Chinese Association of
20 Guam; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
