- 4 Center, commonly known as MARC, was first formed in 1967 by a bill
- 5 introduced by the late Senator Richard F. Taitano, known as Public Law No.

Public Law No. 24-54, introduced by Senators Antonio R. Unpingco, Anthony 2

C. Blaz and Mark Forbes; and

4 WHEREAS, MARC has evolved from an entity directed by the President of the University of Guam to its present status as a research unit, 5 6 and the research unit has acquired and organized the Spanish Documents 7 Collection, the Manuscripts Collection and the Reference Collection (collectively known as the Guam and Micronesia Collections); has transcribed 8 9 and translated documents pertaining to Guam's Spanish Colonial Era; has 10 developed the Spanish Documents Collection's source institutional database; and has obtained the judicial records from the Spanish Administration of the

WHEREAS, MARC additionally has included more recent documents to its collection, including, records of former Governors appointed under the American Administration as well as Governors locally elected; records of locally elected representatives to the U.S. Congress; and records concerning prominent persons who have achieved in other areas, such as education, on Guam; and

WHEREAS, MARC contains a genealogical database devoted to the ancestral heritage of the Chamorro people and has an image database of photographs; and

WHEREAS, MARC has become an excellent and world renowned research source for both scholars of higher learning and persons from the community, and many publications on a great variety of historical and 1 cultural subjects have been funded and distributed through the efforts of

2 MARC; and

WHEREAS, scholars at MARC have contributed to the social and economic development of Guam and Micronesia by studying issues of concern to the peoples of the area such as the effects of tourism, the health of the region's people, indigenous fishing practices and other issues; and

WHEREAS, MARC's threefold mission, namely: (1) to develop a collection of Micronesian and Pacific area materials; (2) to research Guam and Micronesia from direct fieldwork and documentation within and outside the collections; and (3) to communicate the results of this research through publications, teaching and public lectures. This has been wonderfully achieved and continues to unfold with each year's activities of the research unit; and

WHEREAS, the knowledge gained from use of the research unit's large and well-catalogued resources, as well as through dissemination of published materials, has greatly enlightened and enriched the lives of those living in Guam and Micronesia, as well as brought notoriety and acclaim to the research community associated with MARC; and

WHEREAS, each year new knowledge of our history, culture, people, and our region becomes available through the resources of MARC promoting greater understanding and background for future decision making of our island people; now, therefore, be it
