Relative to memorializing the accomplishments of the late Hazime Techemang Telei, Director of the Bureau of Public Safety of the Republic of Palau, and offering condolences to the Telei family.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I***
2 ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Hazime Techemang Telei was commissioned in 1982 as**
4 **a Police Officer I under the Bureau of Public Safety, Palau; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei personified professionalism and integrity in
2 public safety as a Police Officer I and was honorably promoted to Police
3 Officer II in 1982; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei continuously exemplified public safety
5 adeptness and was elected as Vice President of the Board of Directors of the
6 Palau Community Action Agency (PCAA) in 1989, which he served until his
7 death; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was promoted to the rank of Police Sergeant,
9 Bureau of Public Safety in 1991; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was assigned as the Commander of a Special
11 Task Force within the Bureau of Public Safety in 1993; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was assigned as the Crime Stoppers
13 Coordinator and Public Information Officer for the Bureau of Public Safety in
14 1994; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei, ascended to the position of Acting Chief,
16 Division of Corrections in 1995; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was appointed as the Coordinator of the
18 National Emergency Management Office, under the Office of the Vice
19 President of the Republic of Palau in 1997; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was appointed as Director of the Bureau of
21 Public Safety, Republic of Palau on September 28, 2003, and remained there
22 until his death; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was instrumental in the development and
24 initiation of the Micronesian Police Executives Association (MPEA) of which

1 he served as Chairman of the Fourth (4th) Micronesian Police Executives
2 Association (MPEA) from July 2006 to August 2007; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei initiated a resolution at the Thirty-fourth
4 (34th) South Pacific Chiefs of Police (SPCP) Conference in Tonga, which
5 proposed the change of name of the South Pacific Chiefs of Police (SPCP) to
6 the Pacific Islands Chiefs of Police (PICP) to unite in name all members of the
7 organization, and served as Chairman of the Pacific Islands Chiefs of Police
8 (PICP) from July 2006 to October 2007; and


9 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei through his dedicated service, innovation,
10 commitment, and professionalism, profoundly influenced, shaped and
11 molded the Republic of Palau's Bureau of Public Safety into the organization
12 that it is today; now, therefore, be it

14 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
15 people of Guam, extend heartfelt condolences to the family of Mr. Hazime

17 Techemang Telei for his twenty-five (25) years of service to the people of
18 Palau and expresses sincere gratitude for his contributions towards the
19 enhancement of the Law Enforcement network between Guam, Palau, the
20 Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Commonwealth of the Northern
21 Marianas Island (CNMI), the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), and other
22 agencies within the Pacific region; and be it further


23 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
