6 Andersen Air Force Base, Guam, for over four (4) decades, has exemplified
7 stability, commitment, loyalty and longevity as a model employee at his
8 worksite, receiving unprecedented recognition and numerous awards for
9 outstanding service for the greater part of his career including, several letters
10 of Commendation and Superior and Outstanding Performance and Special
11 Achievement Awards twenty (20) times; and

18 *Paka* in 1997 and *Pongsoña* in 2001; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Joe's guidance, leadership, enthusiasm, professionalism

24 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Mr. Joseph Leon Guerrero


1 Manibusan for being a wonderful example of commitment and dedication,
