- 3 WHEREAS, Ryan Lujan Guy was born on March 22, 1990 in San Diego,
- 4 California and to the proud parents, Senator Jesse Anderson Lujan and Mrs.
- 5 Sandra Guy-Willoughby. Ryan is currently residing in Ireland, playing
- 6 professional football for the St. Patrick's Athletics Football Club, a part of the

1 FAI Eircom League of Ireland. Ryan has two (2) younger sisters, Sophia

2 Willoughby, and Jessica Michelle Lujan, a high school senior who recently

received a Scholarship for her Athletic Achievements and Scholastic success

4 by attending Seattle University in the Fall of 2008; and

WHEREAS, Ryan began his soccer career during his childhood years and carried his passion for the sport throughout his youth. From 1995 through 2001, Ryan was a member of the "La Jolla Nomads," where he helped lead his team to becoming the California State Champions in 1998, 1999, and 2000; and the Regional Champions in 2001. Even more rewarding was winning the National Championship in 1999 and 2000, during which time period he was named as the team's "Most Valuable Player" (MVP); and

WHEREAS, Ryan went on to play for the "San Diego Surf," where he helped lead his team to two (2) Regional Championships in 2001 and 2002, as well as two (2) National Championships the same year. During his time as a team member for "San Diego Surf," Ryan was named Team "Most Valuble Player" (MVP) in 2001" and Club "Most Valuable Player" (MVP) in 2002"; and WHEREAS, Ryan maintained the right amount of focus and dedication necessary to develop his skill to a level of performance that was high enough for him to secure a full scholarship to the University of San Diego (USD).

for him to secure a full scholarship to the University of San Diego (USD), where he spent his four (4) years as an undergraduate studying Political Science and Acting/Theatre Arts and playing for the University's Men's Soccer Team. During his years at USD (2003-2007), Ryan marked each year with at least one (1) measurable accomplishment. In school years 2003 to 2004 and 2004 to 2005, he was named Conference Point Leader. As a freshmen, he

- 1 three (3) years of his career earned him even more accolades. Between 2004
- 2 and 2006, Ryan made the All Conference First Team and the All Region Team;
- 3 more notably, he was named Team Most Valuable Player (MVP) each year.
- 4 His college exposure led him to train with Major League Soccer (MLS)
- 5 Colorado Rapids and played for the Colorado Rapids Reserves during the
- 6 summer of 2005; and
- WHEREAS, Ryan's athletic talent has also been exhibited at both a
- 8 National and an International Level. He was a member of the U.S. National
- 9 Pool Under 17 (U-17) Division and is a current member of the U.S. National
- 10 Pool Under 23 (U-23) Division, which he has been a member since 1998. He
- 11 has represented our nation in other countries such as Costa Rica (2000), Italy
- 12 (2001), Brazil (2002), and Germany (2003); and
- 13 WHEREAS, Ryan's passion for the sport of soccer did not stop when
- 14 his collegiate career ended. Ryan has become the first *Chamorro* to be drafted
- 15 to FC Dallas in the 2007 Major League Soccer (MLS) Draft; and the first
- 16 American to play Professional Soccer for the St. Patrick's Athletics Football
- 17 Club, where he plays as either a Wide Midfielder or a Striker/Attacking
- 18 Center Halfback; and
- 19 **WHEREAS**, Ryan has willingly and excitedly agreed to give back to our
- 20 local community through the hosting of a College Prep Seminar and three (3)
- 21 youth Soccer Clinics this Christmas season. These events are to be held at the
- 22 Guam Football Association's Harmon Sports Complex on December 11th, 12th,
- 23 13th, and 15th. The seminar and the clinics are proudly sponsored by Gatorade,
- 24 CarsPlus, Hyundai, KUAM, Monster Energy Drink, Samurai Restaurant, the
- 25 Fiesta Resort, and the Pacific Daily News; now, therefore, be it
