Relative to declaring April 4 to 11, 2008 as "SPAY GUAM WEEK" to provide assistance and encourage island residents to sterilize their pets to help reduce the cat and dog overpopulation of our island, and to extend a warm Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse to the sponsors of the Guam Animals In Need Clinic and the hard working volunteers and workers of GAIN for their commendable service to the community.

- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I

- 3 WHEREAS, cats and dogs provide companionship and share homes with

- 1 thousands of individuals in Guam, and many of our island's residents treat
- 2 their pets as members of the family; and
- WHEREAS, it is unfortunate in Guam, as well as in many other locations,
- 4 that for each pet with a home there are many that are homeless, often running
- 5 wild, causing litter problems, spreading disease, creating nuisances and
- 6 contributing to our island's pet overpopulation problem; and
- WHEREAS, the taxpayers of Guam bear the costs of the problem of pet
- 8 overpopulation, which amounts to thousands of dollars annually, especially
- 9 for animal control programs aimed at coping with the thousands of homeless
- 10 cats and dogs; and

- 11 WHEREAS, Guam Animals In Need (GAIN), Inc., Guam's only humane
- society, has had to euthanize as many as five thousand (5,000) cats and dogs
- 13 each year, although many are healthy and adoptable, due to a lack of critical
- 14 resources such as money, space, and suitable adoptive homes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, spaying and neutering cats and dogs have been proven to
- 16 dramatically reduce the cat and dog overpopulation of our island; and
- 17 WHEREAS, veterinarians, national and local animal protection
- 18 organizations, private citizens and sponsoring organizations have joined
- 19 together with GAIN, Inc., to ensure the spaying and neutering of more than
- 20 three thousand five hundred (3,500) companion animals during annual
- 21 sterilization clinics in the past seven (7) years, and are once again advocating
- 22 the spaying and neutering of companion animals during an eight (8) day
- 23 clinic to be held from April 4 to April 11, 2008; and
 - WHEREAS, the island businesses and organizations that have joined

- 1 with GAIN, Inc., to lend a hand in providing this valuable public service
- 2 include, Continental Air Lines, Pacific Islands Club, Mark V. Pangilinan
- 3 Enterprises, the Pacific Daily News, Budget Car Rental, DGX, Express Signs,
- 4 Guam Cell Communications, Island Equipment, Guam Navy Officers Spouses
- 5 Club, and the HSC-25 Officers Spouses Club; and
- 6 WHEREAS, each business and organization assisting GAIN, Inc.,
- 7 deserves recognition and our island's sincere appreciation for helping to
- 8 reduce our population of homeless animals; now, therefore, be it
- 9 **RESOLVED,** that the Executive Committee of I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na
- 10 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the
- 11 people of Guam, designate April 4 to 11, 2008, as "SPAY GUAM WEEK", and
- does call upon the people of Guam to observe these eight (8) days by having
- their own cats and/or dogs spayed or neutered or by sponsoring the spaying
- 14 and/or neutering of another person's cat or dog; and be it further
- 15 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na
- 16 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the
- 17 people of Guam, extend a warm Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse to the hard
- 18 working volunteers and workers of Guam Animals In Need, Inc., for their
- 19 exemplary service to the community by reducing the number of homeless
- 20 animals by finding them homes and through other means; and be it further
- 21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
- 22 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption
- 23 hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Guam
- 24 Animals In Need, Inc.; to Continental Air Lines; to the Pacific Islands Club; to
