1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I***
2 ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Hawaiian Rock Products, the region's largest producer of
4 aggregate-based construction materials, was established on Guam in 1957 to
5 fill the growing needs of the local community, and the federal and local
6 governments, for industry standard aggregate-based construction materials;

2 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products generates its own raw materials
3 by extracting high quality limestone and coral aggregate material from their
4 quarry located in Mangilao; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in the past fifty (50) years, Hawaiian Rock has literally been
6 a part of our everyday lives here on Guam, with its products used to build the
7 structures we live and work in, drive on and over and across; its three
8 hundred thirty (330) acre site is home to state of the art equipment used to
9 produce ready-mixed and asphalt concrete, the basic products needed in the
10 construction of concrete structures and roads, highways, runways and
11 bridges, earning its products the “Made in Guam” seal; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in addition to their locally made products, the company
13 supplies U.S. branded products and is a licensed contractor on Guam,
14 specializing in highway, runway and airfield-related construction, with a
15 business network that extends throughout the region into Saipan, Tinian and
16 Palau; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the company employs the use of specialized water
18 recycling equipment that provides the resource to make the aggregates to
19 meet specific gradation standards while minimizing its plant’s dependency on
20 water drawn from Guam’s northern area water lenses; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock holds the distinction of employing one
22 hundred percent (100%) of its personnel locally and has actively promoted
23 and contributed to the education of its employees to gain life-long knowledge
24 in every aspect of the industry; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock has been the recipient of numerous awards,
2 commendations, and recognition over the years, including, “Outstanding
3 Contractor of the Year” (1987 & 1988) and “Outstanding Specialty Contractor
4 of the Year” (1992-1993) and in turn, acknowledges, celebrates and rewards its
5 own employees for their dedication and efforts through the company’s
6 monthly employee recognition program; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in addition to half a century of providing quality products
8 and services to our community, Hawaiian Rock is also a generous corporate
9 citizen, contributing to and supporting several charitable organizations, as
10 well as, school groups and scholarship programs, and champions safety issues
11 concerning the local community, providing assistance during times of crises,
12 natural disasters and need; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock is a founding member of the Guam
14 Contractors Association and continues to be a major supporter of the
15 organization; and

16 **WHEREAS**, over the course of fifty (50) years, Hawaiian Rock Products
17 has proven to be an outstanding company, stellar in its field, with dedicated,
18 knowledgeable and experienced employees; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products was nominated for consideration
20 under the “Business Category” for the Guam Chamber of Commerce Guam
21 Business Hall of Fame, and the Chamber of Commerce later selected—on the
22 basis of criteria established by the organization—Hawaiian Rock Products as
23 its “2008 Business Laureate” to be admitted into the Guam Business Hall of
24 Fame; now, therefore, be it
