WHEREAS, the results of more than one hundred (100) program evaluations and at least four (4) experimental studies have yielded definitive evidence that drug courts are demonstratively effective and significantly improve substance-abuse treatment outcomes, substantially reduce crime, and produce greater cost benefits than other justice strategies; and
WHEREAS, the judges, prosecutors, defense attorneys, substance abuse treatment, and rehabilitation professionals, law enforcement and community

supervision personnel, researchers and educators, national and community leaders and others dedicated to the movement have had a profound impact

within their communities; and

WHEREAS, the drug court movement has grown from the twelve (12) original drug courts, in 1994, to 2100 operational drug courts as of December 2007; and

WHEREAS, the week of May 5 to 9, 2008, marks "National Drug Court Commencement Week", which celebrates the promise of recovery, restoring hope to drug court graduates and their families; now, therefore, be it
