3 **WHEREAS, the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute**
4 **National Lodging Management Program (LMP) Competition was held on**

1 April 9 to 11, 2008 at the Shades of Green Resort on the property of the Walt
2 Disney World Resort in Orlando, Florida; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the competition is meant to expose and challenge students
4 to the real-life work experiences they would face in a hotel; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the competition is put on by the Educational Institute,
6 using funding provided by the American Hotel & Lodging Educational
7 Foundation and tasked teams of students to display their proficiency while
8 competing in three (3) contests: Hotel Operations, the Hospitality Project, and
9 the Knowledge Bowl; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the LMP is a National Educational Program for High
11 School Juniors and Seniors that covers topics in the program, including,
12 lodging management, front office and housekeeping management, leadership
13 skills, marketing and sales, and food and beverage service; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in 1977, the Guam Community College established its
15 Lodging Management Program and has conducted the program in each of
16 Guam's public high schools, hosting its own local competition to decide the
17 Guam representative to the National LMP Competition held annually in
18 Orlando, Florida; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Guam representative for 2008 was the team from Simon
20 Sanchez High School, comprised of members: Rosewin Marasigan, Sherry
21 Gozum, Lerio Abinales and Persha Amparo, under the guidance of Instructor
22 Norman Aguilar; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in all, thirteen (13) teams competed, representing schools in
24 Arkansas, Florida, New Hampshire, New York, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania,

1 South Carolina, Texas, Arizona, Hawaii, Ohio, and Washington, D.C., as well
2 as from Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Simon Sanchez High School team is the 1st group from
4 Guam to place in the top three (3) at the National Lodging Management
5 Competition, including placing Second (2nd) in the Overall Competition,
6 taking Second (2nd) Place in the Knowledge Bowl, and earning Second (2nd)
7 Place in the Hospitality Project; now, therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
10 people of Guam, recognize the Simon Sanchez High School LMP team as the
11 first team representing our island to place in the top three (3) of the American
12 Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute National Lodging Management
13 Program Competition; and, be it further

16 congratulations to the team and its instructor for their placing Second (2nd) in

18 and earning Second (2nd) Place in the Hospitality Project; and, be it further


19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Executive
