WHEREAS, with the support of her parents and college scholarships,
Felisa was the first from both sides of her family to earn a higher education
degree; and

English as a Second Language as part of the Department of Education's Adult
Basic Education Program; and

1 WHEREAS, in 1972, Felisa became Assistant Principal at George 2 Washington High School for one (1) year; from 1973 to 1976 she was Principal 3 of Barrigada Junior High; and in 1977, she returned to the Department of 4 Education Central Office and was the Associate Superintendent of Personnel 5 Services Division for fifteen (15) years where she would stay until her 6 retirement after thirty-seven (37) years of service to the government of Guam, 7 working tirelessly to improve our public educational system; and

WHEREAS, Felisa balanced her professional career with a mirror 8 9 commitment to civic engagement, serving on many community organizations, she was a Girl Scout Leader in Sinajana from 1955 to 1958; PTA member at 1011 Carlos Elementary School from 1956 to 1978, and she served in various school committees at other schools; she was a member of the University of Guam's 12 13 Teacher Training Program Selection Committee, as well as a member of the selection committee for the Government of Guam JET Program, and is a junior 14 level education training program, a member of the International Reading 15 Association (IRA) from 2005 to present; and 16

WHEREAS, in her retired life, Felisa continues to make a difference inour community by volunteering her services as a Pre-GED teacher; and
