- 3 WHEREAS, Lorenzo C. Cruz, also known as "Tun Larry" or "Mr.

- 6 WHEREAS, Maria Cruz Materne, also known as "Tan Maria", "Mrs.

- 2 December 2, 1930 to Antonio Mafnas Materne and Dolores Mesa Cruz; and
- 3 **WHEREAS**, *Tun* Larry affectionately recalls that it was sixty (60) years
- 4 ago when he first saw Tan Maria, while they were attending George
- 5 Washington High School in Sinajana; and while there were three (3) other
- 6 girls he was courting, he knew that *Tan* Maria was the one he would marry
- 7 and it took some creative maneuvering to convince her that he was the right
- 8 man for her; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, unlike *Tun* Larry, it was not love at first sight for *Tan* Maria
- 10 and she did not care for *Tun* Larry at the time and already had a boyfriend;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, Tan Maria knew that Tun Larry liked her because he
- 13 followed her everywhere and was always watching her, including one time
- 14 when he was driving and was eyeing her in the back seat of the car through
- 15 his rear view mirror; and
- 16 **WHEREAS**, there were other ways *Tun* Larry tried to win *Tan* Maria
- 17 over, including giving his cousin money to buy her treats which she knew
- 18 were really coming from *Tun* Larry; and
- 19 **WHEREAS**, after all the courting, it was when *Tun* Larry serenaded her
- 20 early in the morning at her home that *Tan* Maria fell in love with him and she
- 21 quit with her boyfriend to be with *Tun* Larry and asked her mother to allow
- 22 him to come to their home; and
- 23 WHEREAS, on June 28, 1948, they were married at Santa Barbara
- 24 Church in Dededo, in a wedding ceremony officiated by Father Mel

- 1 McCormick, OFM Cap; and
- 2 WHEREAS, the couple had seven (7) sons: the first born being a boy
- 3 who died at birth; Anthony Frank; Jlawrence; Henry Michael; Frank Edward;
- 4 who died at the age of two (2); Joseph Luis; and Daniel Gabriel. They also
- 5 included in their family several reared children and extended family: Doris
- 6 Materne Blas Aguon, Rosita Materne Iglesias, Marie Materne Camacho, Jesse
- 7 Bais and Theodore Bais; and
- 8 WHEREAS, they have sixteen (16) grandchildren and four (4) great-
- 9 grandchildren; and
- 10 WHEREAS, during the sixty (60) years of marriage, they opened their
- 11 home to many other family members to live with them and welcomed them as
- 12 part of their family; and
- WHEREAS, as a young girl, *Tan* Maria was a member of the Sodality of
- 14 Mary for single girls, and once married, she became a full time housewife to
- 15 raise their children and take care of the family while *Tun* Larry worked long
- 16 hours as a taxi driver and later worked with the Federal Government, from
- which he retired after thirty-nine (39) years; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Tan Maria and Tun Larry both agreed that the most
- 19 challenging times for them were when their children were off-island for
- school and military, and the most precious times were when *Tun* Larry finally
- 21 retired and their children were all back on island and were all together as a
- 22 family; and
- 23 **WHEREAS**, after retirement with the Federal Government, *Tun* Larry
- 24 still desired to continue to work and for the past several years has worked

1 with numerous Senatorial Offices where he has been an important asset to the

staff of David Shimizu, Lou Leon Guerrero, and currently with ben

3 pangelinan; and

WHEREAS, old traditions remain during their years of marriage including preparing good meals for the family and even to this day, *Tan* Maria makes sure that *Tun* Larry has his meals ready for him every morning before he goes to work at the office and when he comes home to get ready to work at the ranch; and

WHEREAS, *Tan* Maria's occupation is housewife for sixty (60) years and *Tun* Larry's official occupation is *Tan* Maria's assistant; now, therefore, be it
