**Relative to recognizing and commending Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido as the last remaining defender of Wake Island, and to congratulating him on his selection and appointment to be Grand Marshall for the 64<sup>th</sup> Liberation Day Parade.**

- 1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3        **WHEREAS, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido and the thirty-five (35)**  
4        **surviving *Chamorros* were first sent to Japan and then to a prison camp in**

1 Woosung, China, where they were imprisoned for three (3) years. Two (2)  
2 Chamorro men died in prison. After the war ended, thirty-three (33) brave  
3 survivors returned to Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido and the thirty-three (33)  
5 survivors were finally honored for their heroic services in 1988, when  
6 Congress recognized the surviving Wake Island Defenders as Veterans of the  
7 United States Navy and granted military benefits. The survivors were  
8 honorably discharged and awarded the Prisoner of War Medal; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido was married for sixty (60)  
10 years to Mrs. Maria Castro Carbullido; and


11 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido and Mrs. Maria Castro  
12 Carbullido are the proud parents of ten (10) Children: Bernice C. Pearson;

14 Miller; Vincent J. Carbullido; Paul J. Carbullido; Gina C. Munoz; Pilar C.  
15 Carbullido; and Dr. Eduardo Cruz; and


16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido is the last remaining  
17 defender of the Wake Island during World War II and the last remaining  
18 survivor of the Wake Island Prison Camp; and in recognition of his service  
19 and heroism, Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido has been named by the 64<sup>th</sup>  
20 Liberation day Committee as Grand Marshall for the 64<sup>th</sup> Liberation Day  
21 Parade; now, therefore, be it

23 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
24 people of Guam, recognize and commend Mr. Francisco Chaco Carbullido for

1 his numerous accomplishments and his courageous service to his country and  
2 island and does further congratulate Mr. Carbullido on his appointment as  
3 Grand Marshall for the 64<sup>th</sup> Liberation Day Parade; and be it further  
4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Executive  
5 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption  
6 hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr. Francisco
