3        **WHEREAS, Francisco S.N. Flores passed away on July 22, 2008, after**  
4        **serving as a career firefighter for thirty (30) years and had retired in October**  
5        **1985; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, on May 16, 1983, Francisco S.N. Flores became the first  
2 *Chamorro* Fire Chief at Naval Station Guam; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores was married to the former Mercedes  
4 Castro Guerrero; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores had seven (7) children: Frank H.  
6 Flores, Louisa A. Kurkowski, Lucretia F. Pangelinan, Emilia F. Rice, Nacrina F.  
7 Mendiola, Oscar G. Flores, and Isaac G. Flores; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores also had twenty-one (21)  
9 grandchildren and thirteen (13) great-grandchildren; and

10          **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores, in addition to his professional  
11 accomplishments, also served his island community by being active in several  
12 civic organizations involving children; and

13          **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores had served as a Scoutmaster and was  
14 the Chairman of numerous fundraising committees for schools and churches;

16          **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores was a past President of the  
17 Firefighter's Welfare Association and the International Association of  
18 Firefighters; and

19          **WHEREAS**, Francisco S.N. Flores served as a Board Member of the  
20 Naval Marianas Federal Credit Union, as the Chairperson of the Equal  
21 Opportunity Committee, and as a Member of the Training Committee at  
22 Naval Station Guam; now, therefore, be it

24 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the

3 community; and be it further


4       **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Executive
