1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

3           **WHEREAS,** Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran  
4 Carbullido of Agat, is the son of Mr. Anthony J. and Mrs. Aurora F.  
5 Carbullido. He was born on August 25, 1982 and is the brother of Austin and  
6 Ashley Carbullido; and

7           **WHEREAS,** Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran  
8 Carbullido was a member of the Southern High School cross-country team  
9 and *Korun Minagof*, and graduated with the school’s Class of 2000. Petty  
10 Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido was a member of  
11 the Twenty-first (21<sup>st</sup>) Guam Youth Congress and was elected Vice Speaker in  
12 the Twenty-second (22<sup>nd</sup>) Guam Youth Congress. He was as an Altar Server  
13 at his village parish, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church and enjoyed  
14 running, fishing, diving, and other outdoor sports; and

15           **WHEREAS,** Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran  
16 Carbullido chose to follow the footsteps of his father at age eighteen (18) and  
17 joined the United States Armed Forces by enlisting in another Branch, the U.S.  
18 Navy, in the fall of 2000. Following basic training at Great Lakes, Illinois, he  
19 was stationed at the Naval Medical Center in San Diego, California; and

20           **WHEREAS,** on September 26, 2007, Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony  
21 “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido married Summer Chaney and are blessed  
22 with a daughter Lexie; Summer is the daughter of Mr. Edward Leo Chaney

3       **WHEREAS**, Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran  
4 Carbullido proved to be an excellent soldier, ascended the ranks to his recent  
5 designation of Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class, and was recently assigned to the Naval  
6 Hospital Corps School in Great Lakes, Illinois, as an instructor; and

7       **WHEREAS**, Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran  
8 Carbullido was first deployed to Iraq as a corpsman in 2004. His second (2<sup>nd</sup>)  
9 deployment was to Afghanistan in 2008 as a corpsman assigned with the 1st  
10 Supply Battalion, Combat Logistics Regiment 15 out of Camp Pendleton,  
11 California. Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Carbullido’s most recent assignment was  
12 with the 207th R SAC WEST/HERAT/SHINDAND; and

13       **WHEREAS**, *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* joins our island  
14 community in paying tribute to the late United States Navy Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup>  
15 Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido, an outstanding young man  
16 who cared for his country and his island, and who has become one of  
17 America's heroes, having made the ultimate sacrifice, and his memory will  
18 forever live in the hearts of his wife and parents, his extended family, and  
19 many of his closest friends; now, therefore, be it

23 of America and the people of Guam, and for his making the ultimate sacrifice


1 in combat while serving in the United States Armed Services on August 8,
