5 Philippines; and

6 **WHEREAS**, as a young man in 1971, Mr. Sales decided to take a job as a
7 construction worker and come to Guam to seek a better life; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1974 he married Juanita, the love of his life, and they
9 have three (3) children, Russell, Jeannette and Lyrra, and two (2)
10 grandchildren; and

11 **WHEREAS**, deciding that a more permanent and dependable job than
12 construction was best for raising a family, Mr. Sales sought employment with
13 the Government of Guam, and was hired for a position in the Housing
14 Maintenance Division of the Department of Administration in 1975; and

15 **WHEREAS**, after a year in Housing Maintenance, Mr. Sales moved to
16 the Department of Parks and Recreation, where he took a position in the
17 Division of Parks Maintenance, a job he held for eight (8) years until 1984; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in 1984, Mr. Sales changed employment once again, moving
19 to the Chief Public Health Office at the Department of Public Health and
20 Social Services, where he filled the position of Maintenance Specialist in the
21 Dental Division; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Sales served in this capacity for twenty-four (24) years,
2 even winning Employee of the Year honors, and was a model worker for the
3 entire length of his employment; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Sales has also been active in our community, serving as
5 a member of the United Zambales Foundation of Guam, and currently
6 holding the position of Vice President; and

7 **WHEREAS**, as Vice President, Mr. Sales has helped to ensure that the
8 organization provides support and assistance to its members in times of
9 emergency and great need; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in September, 2008, Mr. Sales retired from the Government
11 of Guam after thirty-six (36) years of hard work and dedicated service toward
12 the betterment of our island and the improvement of our community; and

14 been a man of integrity who has always been respectful of others and is a
15 source of inspiration for his colleagues, friends, and family; now therefore, be

22 thirty-three (33) years of hard work and dedicated service as an employee of


1 the Government of Guam, toward the betterment of our island and the
