WHEREAS, Dr. Hanson, throughout his academic career, has been recognized for his academic abilities with membership in the National Honor Society, Phi Beta Kappa, Alpha Omega Alpha, recognition as a Summerfield Scholar at the University of Kansas, and graduated from the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at the University of Kansas "with highest distinction"; and

WHEREAS, some of Dr. Hanson's professional responsibilities include,

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Arizona; from 1992 to present, Clinical Internist – Volunteer – Outpatient
 Clinic, Hu-Hu-Kam Memorial Hospital; and

Halsey, PhD 10 11 Department of Biochemistry University of Kansas Medical Center), Assisting 12 in the analysis of the Long Island Breast Cancer Study in assessing the role of 13 exogenous hormones as a risk factor for carcinoma of the female breast (1990-1991, Sponsor: André O. Varma, MD, MSc - Department of Preventive 14 Medicine SUNY), and Conducting epidemiologic research on diabetes 15 16 mellitus and other chronic diseases among the Pima Indians in Arizona, (1991-17 Supervisor: William C.
