3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy was born on November 11, 1950, in Manila,**
4 **Philippines, to proud parents Lino H. Uy and Yong So Ching; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Uy attended St. Stephen’s High School in the
2 Binondo District of Manila, Philippines, during his grade school years. Mr.
3 Emelio Uy then earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Commerce from the
4 University of Santo Tomas in 1971; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Uy arrived on Guam in November 1981 and
6 started his business, the National Office Supply, in January 1982 as Vice-
7 President and General Manager; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Uy has been an active member of Guam’s
9 community, as evidenced by a list of accomplishments and commendations
10 from various civic, professional and government organizations, most notably
11 the Lions Club International, where he served as the District Governor for
12 District 204 from 1996 to 1997. He continues to serve as the Extension
13 Chairman for the Lions Club District 204. He is also currently a member of
14 the Board of Directors for the Guam Museum Foundation; a member of the
15 Board of Advisers for the University of Santo Tomas Alumni Association of
16 Guam; a two-term President of the Filipino Community of Guam from 1998
17 and again in 2001 to 2002; and a former member of the Board of Directors for
18 the American Red Cross; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Uy has received numerous awards and
20 recognition from Guam and the Philippines, such as, the Banaag Award; the
21 Presidential Award of the Philippines from President Fidel Ramos given to
22 him in 1996; the Golden Scroll Award from the Young Achievers Foundation

1 in March 1994; a Certificate of Recognition from the Secretary of Foreign
2 Affairs of the Philippines, Raul Manglapuz, in 1990; Guam's Most
3 Distinguished Volunteer Award from First Lady Roseanne Ada in 1990; the
4 Golden Latte Award from the Guam Visitors Bureau in 2006; a
5 Commendation from the University of Guam Intercollegiate Athletic Council
6 in 2006; an Outstanding Achievement Award in 1992 and 1995 from the
7 Consul General of the Philippines; and the *Maga'laha*n Award for the Arts
8 from the Governor of Guam in 1994 and 1995; now, therefore, be it


9 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
