3 WHEREAS, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) was 4 established in 1953 to provide financial, technical, and management 5 assistance to small businesses encourage their expansion and to sustain 6 their growth throughout the nation's states and territories; and

WHEREAS, America's estimated 25.8 million small businesses
employ more than half of the nation's private work force, generate more
than half of the nation's gross domestic product and are the principal
source of new jobs in the U.S. economy; and

WHEREAS, Guam's estimated three thousand (3,000) business
establishments contribute forty-one percent (41%) to the island's total
monthly payroll, accounting for nearly forty-three thousand (43,000)
employees in the private sector; and

WHEREAS, the SBA first opened its Guam Branch Office in 1962, and it provides loan guarantees to participating lending institutions in Guam for the island's small businesses, thus ensuring the needed capital to maintain the viability of our small business concerns, adding to our island's tax base and providing employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, since 1990, the SBA Guam Branch Office has participated in the annual nationwide SBA "Small Business Awards" program, recognizing the achievements of both Guam's small business owners and those advocates of both small business in Guam, and providing aspiring island entrepreneurs with successful role models;

3 WHEREAS, this year's "2007 Guam Financial Services Champion 4 of the Year," Mike W. Naholowaa, Vice President with the Bank of 5 Guam, has donated many hours of his personal time to advocacy efforts 6 to increase the usefulness and availability of accounting or financial 7 services to small businesses; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Naholowaa has been instrumental in the 9 development of community organizations such as the Junior 10 Achievement (JA) of Guam and has served as Chairman of the Advisory 11 Council of the UOG School of Business and Public Administration, 12 which assists in the start-up of small businesses; and

WHEREAS, Mike has contributed his financial expertise, insight,
and assistance to legislation that promotes small businesses; and

WHEREAS, Mike has held numerous leadership positions in
community-based organizations, including Vice Chairman, Guam
Institute of Banking; President, Saipan Chamber of Commerce;
Secretary/Treasurer, Saipan Rotary Club; Chairman, CNMI Banking
Association; and Vice-Chairman, Commonwealth Development Loan
Fund; and

WHEREAS, Mike currently holds the following executive
positions: Chairman, UOG School of Business and Public
Administration Advisory Council; Board Member, Junior Achievement
of Guam; Member, Armed Services Committee of the Guam Chamber of
