## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I

- 2 MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
- WHEREAS, over thirty-five (35) years ago, a young local banker named
- 4 Jesus Sablan Leon Guerrero conceived a dream to establish Guam's first
- 5 locally owned bank; and
- 6 WHEREAS, with his vision, experience, reputation and energy, Mr.
- 7 Leon Guerrero literally hit the streets with his plan, convinced numerous

- 1 individuals to invest in the bank and raised over One Million Five Hundred
- 2 Thousand Dollars (\$1.5 Million) in start-up capital; and
- WHEREAS, on March 13, 1972, the Bank of Guam was officially
- 4 chartered with Mr. Jesus Sablan Leon Guerrero as the Chairman of the Board,
- 5 and on December 11, 1972, the Bank of Guam opened doors to the public in a
- 6 modest pre-fabricated building in *Hagåtña* staffed by thirteen (13) employees;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, within two (2) years of opening, the Bank had constructed
- 9 a three-story, 24,000 square foot office building in *Hagåtña* and bank resources
- 10 had reached over Thirty Three Million Dollars (\$33 Million); and
- 11 **WHEREAS**, over the years, the Bank has opened branches in Guam, the
- 12 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the Federated States of
- 13 Micronesia, the Republic of Belau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands and
- 14 San Francisco, California; and
- WHEREAS, in 1992, the Bank opened a new ten (10) story headquarters
- 16 in *Hagåtña*, expanded to nineteen (19) branches, established fifteen (15) Pacific
- 17 Express Teller machines and held resources of over Six Hundred Million
- 18 Dollars (\$600 Million) and recorded profits of Eight Million One Hundred
- 19 Thousand Dollars (\$8.1 Million); and
- 20 WHEREAS, in 1992, Mr. Anthony A. Leon Guerrero was appointed
- 21 President and Chief Executive Officer of the Bank; and
- 22 WHEREAS, on August 27, 2002, the Founder and Chairman of the
- 23 Board, Mr. Jesus Sablan Leon Guerrero passed away, leaving behind an
- 24 institution just as he had envisioned it, an institution that made a difference in

- 1 the community, staffed by professionally trained employees, and prepared to
- 2 meet the future needs of island communities; and
- 3 WHEREAS, on October 9, 2005, Anthony A. Leon Guerrero, President
- 4 and Board Chairman passed away; and
- 5 WHEREAS, on April 3, 2006, Ms. Lourdes "Lou" Leon Guerrero, a six
- 6 (6) term Guam Senator, was appointed the Bank's President and Board Chair;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Ms. Lou Leon Guerrero, the Bank
- 9 of Guam has continued to support new businesses through sponsorship of the
- 10 Women in Business and the Pacific Islands Microcredit Institute; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Ms. Lourdes "Lou" Leon Guerrero was inducted into the
- 12 Guam Chamber of Commerce 2006 Hall of Fame; and
- 13 WHEREAS, for thirty-five (35) years, the Bank of Guam has been the
- 14 leader in supporting the needs of our island, donating funds to such
- 15 organizations as the University of Guam, the American Red Cross, the
- 16 American Cancer Society, the Make A Wish Foundation, Catholic Social
- 17 Services, Crime Stoppers, Rainbows for Children, the Guam Humanities
- 18 Council and to many more worthwhile causes; and
- 19 WHEREAS, today, the Bank of Guam, "I Bankon Ifit", is proud of thirty-
- 20 five (35) years of successful operations, employing over four hundred twenty
- 21 (420) employees, operating twenty-two (22) branches throughout Micronesia,
- 22 and providing a full complement of on-line banking services; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the Bank of Guam is prepared to meet the needs of its
- 24 customers for the next thirty-five (35) years through its vision, innovation,
- 25 service and commitment; now, therefore, be it
