1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Peter John Pereira Muña was born on June 7, 1939 in**
4 **the village of Tamuning to Colonel Juan Muña and Rita Cruz Pereira Muña;**
5 **and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Peter Muña attended school in Barrigada and
2 graduated from George Washington High School in June 1960; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Peter Muña married the former Dolores Anderson
4 Muña on May 4, 1963 and they have been husband and wife for more than
5 forty-three (43) years; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Peter and Dolores Muña have been blessed with six (6)
7 children: Steven, Stephanie (deceased), David, Daniel, Dominic, and Darren;
8 and seven (7) grandchildren: Stephanie, Trisha, Amanda, David, Bryan,
9 Isabella, and Zachary; and one (1) great-grandchild, Micah Elias; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Peter Muña has always been active in island sports,
11 having played in his teens and early twenties for the Barrigada baseball team;
12 and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Peter Muña, an accomplished self-taught musician
14 performing primarily as a drummer, played in island bands for more than
15 twenty-five (25) years; and

16 **WHEREAS**, he initially began drumming for the Guam Militia and
17 eventually played for such notable bands as the Bill Muña Band and The Five
18 Locals; and

19 **WHEREAS**, he was fortunate to be playing with longtime Guam
20 musicians such as: Bill Muña, former Senator Antonio Cruz, Nito Cristobal,
21 Fred Leon Guerrero, Al Pangelinan, Forrest Harris, Norbert Tydingco and
22 many others; and

1 **WHEREAS**, for many years in the sixties and early seventies, the band
2 was the “must have” band for nightclubs, weddings, christenings, birthday
3 parties, fiestas and off-island events on Saipan; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Peter Muña’s career in law enforcement began when he
5 became a Deputy Marshal in the Superior Court of Guam in November 1965;
6 and in July of 1977, he was promoted to Deputy Marshal IV; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in July 1982, as a result of his accomplishments and work
8 ethic, he was promoted to Deputy Marshal Supervisor; and

9 **WHEREAS**, after almost twenty (20) dedicated years in the Marshal’s
10 Office of the Superior Court, Mr. Peter Muña became the island’s Chief
11 Marshal, supervising over twenty (20) employees; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in September 1987, Mr. Peter John Pereira Muña proudly
13 retired from government service, leaving behind a legacy of hard work,
14 commitment and tireless dedication; and


15 **WHEREAS**, despite his retirement, he managed a Process Serving
16 business for the next three (3) years until his health made it difficult for him to
17 continue; now, therefore, be it

23 further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
