3 **WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2007, the University of Guam, a Land Grant
4 Institution, will observe its Charter Day, marking its founding; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Territorial College of Guam, which was founded in
6 1952, offering limited classes at the old George Washington High School

1 campus in Mongmong, developed from a two (2) year Teacher Training
2 institution to a Land Grant University that offers a full range of
3 undergraduate and graduate programs and relocated to its present 100 acre
4 campus overlooking Pago Bay in Mangilao in 1961; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Territorial College of Guam was renamed the
6 “University of Guam” by the Ninth (9th) Guam Legislature after being
7 accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (“WASC”) in
8 1968; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the University of Guam’s first Charter Day was proclaimed
10 on December 17, 1968 by the Honorable Governor Manuel F.L. Guerrero; and

11 **WHEREAS**, this year marks the Fifty-fifth (55th) Anniversary of the
12 founding of the University of Guam and the Thirty-ninth (39th) Charter Day
13 Celebration; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the University of Guam continues to contribute to the
15 Island’s social, cultural, political and economic advancement; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the theme for this year, “*Awakening Identities: Culture,*
17 *Creativity and Academe*”, reflects the vision and mission of the University of
18 Guam to provide higher education for the people of Guam, the islands of the
19 Western Pacific and the Asian Pacific Rim nations; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the University invites the people of Guam to visit the
21 Mangilao campus during the week and share in numerous cultural, social,
22 educational and recreational activities; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Harold L. Allen, Ph.D., President of the University,
24 appointed the 2007 Charter Day Committee to organize this year’s activities,

20 historic event; and be it further


21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
