1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I* 2 *MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

3 WHEREAS, "National Crime Victims' Rights Week" was declared 4 twenty-seven (27) years ago by President Ronald W. Reagan to focus the 5 Nation's attention on those who have fallen victim to crime; and 1 WHEREAS, through volunteer support programs, the people of Guam 2 and our nation can reflect on the devastating impact that crime and terrorism 3 have on their victims and their families, and how we as a community can 4 strengthen our resolve to address all victims' needs; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1981, crime victim assistance has grown from a 6 handful of support programs to over ten thousand (10,000) community-based 7 and justice system programs with more than thirty-two thousand (32,000) 8 federal and state statutes that define and protect the rights of crime victims 9 and survivors; and

10 WHEREAS, community-based organizations and government agencies such as the Office of the Attorney General's Victim Witness Ayuda Services; 11 12 the Guam Police Department Criminal Investigation Section and Victim 13 Assistance Unit; the Guam Fire Department; the Department of Corrections 14 Parole Services; the Judiciary's Marshal and Probation Divisions; the Catholic Social Services ALEE Shelter; the Victim Advocates Reaching Out; the Erica's 15 House; the Guam Legal Services Corporation; the Guma' Mami, Inc.; the 16 Archdiocese of Agana; the Public Defender Service Corporation; the 17 18 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, Healing Hearts Crisis 19 Center; the Department of Public Health and Social Services Child and Adult 20 Protective Services Divisions; the Sanctuary, Inc.; the Sexual Assault Victim 21 Intervention Advocates; the Andersen Family Advocacy Program; the Navy 22 Family Advocacy Committee; the Superior Court of Guam Client Services and 23 Family Counseling Division; the Department of Youth Affairs; the Governor's 24 Community Outreach Federal Programs Office; the Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD); the Office of the Public Guardian; the Rainbows for all 25

Children; and the *Inafa' Maolek* continue to provide services to crime victims
 and survivors; and

3 WHEREAS, while major progress has been made in protecting and 4 supporting victims of crime, we must ensure that all victims and their 5 survivors are treated with dignity and respect and given the resources to 6 recover and be free from violence; and

WHEREAS, our island joins the Nation in recognizing the week of April
22nd through 28th, 2007, as "National Crime Victims' Rights Week" with the
theme: "Victims' Rights: Every Victim, Every Time"; now, therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na* 11 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the 12 people of Guam, encourage our island to join the nation in honoring and 13 valuing the lives of victims of crime and survivors for their ability to 14 overcome obstacles and to restore their lives; and be it further
