Relative to recognizing the accomplishments and dedication of the late Ruben D. Basilio, M.D., affectionally known as "Dr. B." or "Uncle Doctor"; and to extending humble and sincere condolences to his loving wife Lourdes and family on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam.

## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I 2 MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the late Ruben D. Basilio, M.D. was born on September 13,
1936, and was called to his eternal rest on June 3, 2007 at the age of seventy
(70); and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio's legacy will live on in the hearts and memories
of his loving wife, Lourdes Cruz Basilio; his daughter, Rita Mae and husband
Andrew Chan and grandchildren Nicholas and Elena; his son David and wife
Lori and grandson Anthony; his son Nino and wife Christi and
granddaughters, Marissa and Hannah; and his youngest daughter Beata and
husband William Triplett; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio earned his Doctor of Medicine Degree from the
University of St. Tomas, College of Medicine and Surgery, Manila, Philippines
in 1961 and soon passed the Philippine Medical Board. The young doctor
completed his Residency in Internal Medicine at the Veterans Memorial
Hospital in Quezon City, PI in 1963; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio Interned at Coney Island Hospital, Brooklyn, New York, New York from 1963 to 1964, and conducted his Residency in Internal Medicine at Brooklyn Veterans Affairs Hospital, Brooklyn, from 1964 to 1967. In 1968, he was appointed as a Fellow in the Renal and Electrolyte Section (Nephrology) at the Brooklyn VA Hospital, and in Gastro-Enterology at the Brookdale Hospital and Medical Center, State University of New York, College of Medicine; and

WHEREAS, in 1970, Dr. Basilio returned to his roots when he accepted the appointment as Chief of Nephrology at the Veterans Memorial Hospital in Quezon City, PI, and pioneered the First (1<sup>st</sup>) Dialysis Unit there while he served as the Medical Director. In 1972, Dr. Basilio was the Nephrologist for the team that conducted the first renal transplant in the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, in 1974, Ruben D. Basilio, M.D., brought his expertise and
 his family to the island of Guam at the invitation of the late Honorable Senator
 Ernesto M. Espaldon, M.D., F.A.C.S; and

WHEREAS, within a year of his relocation to the island, Dr. Basilio
established the First (1<sup>st</sup>) Dialysis Unit on Guam and served as the
Hemodialysis Medical Director at the Guam Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, in 1975, Dr. Ruben Basilio partnered with Dr. Benjamin
Sison and opened his first private practice on Guam, the ITC Clinic at the
International Trade Center in Tamuning; and

WHEREAS, in 1981, Dr. Basilio was the Medical Director of the first
Health Maintenance Organization for the island, dba: "The Guam Memorial
Health Plan"; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio founded the former Pacific Dialysis Corporation in Dededo; the Guam Renal Care, in *Hagatna*; the Guam Dialysis Center in Tamuning; and most recently, through a partnership with Dr. Saied Safa, the Pacific Medical Group, which opened in 2005 and offers a full range of medical practices; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio's vision, foresight, hard work and steadfast
commitment greatly improved the quality of life and the health of the people
of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio was involved in the community as a member of
the Guam Medical Society and an advisor to the Guam Renal Organization.
He enjoyed the fullness of life, and tennis, and was an avid fan of the San
Antonio Spurs of NBA fame; and
