Relative to commending and congratulating Mr. Franklin A. Perez, Police Officer III, Guam Police Department; Recipient of the Guam Police Department's "2007 Police Officer of the Year" Award.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I
2 *LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

3 WHEREAS, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez was born on January
4 16, 1965 and raised in the village of Santa Rita; and is married to his high
5 school sweetheart Mary Jane Torres and are proud parents of three (3)
6 children, Verronica Lorissa, Naedine Renae, and Matthew James; and

7 WHEREAS, in October 1985, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez
8 enlisted in the United States Marine Corps (USMC) and proudly served our
9 country for four (4) years before being honorably discharged on September
10 16, 1989; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez returned back to his
2 island home and began his professional career with the Guam Police
3 Department (GPD) after graduating from the Police Academy on May 12,
4 1991; and

5 **WHEREAS**, from 1991-1994, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez was
6 assigned to various precincts of the Neighborhood Patrol Division and in
7 September 1994 was transferred to the Traffic Investigation Section, now
8 known as the Highway Patrol Division; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in November 1999, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez
10 resigned his position with GPD to further expand his skills and training
11 and seek other opportunities abroad; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in December 2001, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez
13 continued his law enforcement career with Dyncorp International serving
14 as an International Civilian Police Officer in Kosovo under the United
15 Nations. After serving as a patrol officer for one (1) month, Police Officer
16 III Franklin A. Perez was assigned to a new unit to assist in the
17 development and implementation of the Kosovo Organized Crime Bureau.
18 Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez ended his tour with Dyncorp
19 International in December 2003; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez returned home in
21 January 2004 and continued his law enforcement career, once again, with

1 the Guam Police Department where he his presently assigned to the
2 Highway Patrol Division as a Crash Homicide
3 Investigator/Reconstructionist; now, therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
5 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan* and the
6 people of Guam, join in commending and congratulating Police Officer III
7 Franklin A. Perez in recognition of him receiving the Guam Police
8 Department's "2007 Police Officer of the Year" award bestowed upon him
9 on May 18th, 2007; and be it further

10 **RESOLVED**, the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*
11 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan*,
12 recognizes that Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez has brought great honor
13 and distinction to himself, the Guam Police Department and the island
14 community by his commitment and dedication in ensuring that our island
15 and community is safe and secure; and be it further

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
17 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attests to, the
18 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to
19 Police Officer III Franklin A. Perez; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho,
20 *I Maga'Lahen Guåhan*.
