Relative to commending Staff Sergeant Don D. Adriano, United States Air Force, for his highly successful tour of duty on Guam and particularly for the efforts to promote a better relationship between the United States Air Force and the people of Guam

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2        ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Don G. Adriano, a career NCO who came to  
4        Andersen Air force Base, Guam in February 2005, and has given unselfishly in  
5        promoting friendship and cultural awareness between the United States Air  
6        Force and the people of Guam and who has had an outstanding tour of duty  
7        in Guam, where his presence will be surely missed by friends in the military  
8        as well as the civilian community; and

9        **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Don G. Adriano, a Customer Support Controller  
10       from California, was assigned as Lead Operations Management Journeyman,  
11       36<sup>th</sup> Civil Engineer Squadron has shown deep compassion for the people of  
12       Guam by his efforts in supporting Guam's HASSO program, His selfless  
13       dedication has helped keep Guam's coastal areas in their beautiful natural

1 condition. Furthermore, his efforts ensured better living conditions for the  
2 animals when he led 12 airmen on a total Guam Animals In Need makeover  
3 turning a jungle into a paradise spending 8 hours of cleaning kennels, feeding  
4 animals, cutting grass, and repairing fences. He aided in providing schools  
5 with computer equipment through ADPE program; by collecting computers,  
6 monitors, printers, and computer hardware. He volunteered to be a part of  
7 the International Christian Assembly music team as a musician; and

8         **WHEREAS**, he was a Catalyst for Andersen AFB/Guam Community  
9 relations; he manned water station for the Guam' s First Annual Koko Race  
10 supported more than 1K runners and improved Guam' s tourism. He was  
11 also an active booster club member volunteering a total of 40 hours for two  
12 consecutive years as a tour guide for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> annual CE haunted house;  
13 which raised a total of 3K for squadron morale activities. As a proactive Air  
14 Force Sergeants Association member, he helped raised \$1K by assisting with  
15 doing gift wrap activities; and

16         **WHEREAS**, SSgt Adriano was a champion of support to Team  
17 Andersen' s quality of life; he maintained 1,860 facilities comprising 6.9  
18 million sq ft throughout 15 geographical sites; processed over 9,000 AF Form  
19 332 work orders for consideration at weekly Work Request Review Board

1 (WRRB). He managed 78 in-house work orders valued at \$200K for newly  
2 established TOP 36 Program; ensured equal balance among group monitors  
3 for 332' s--improved facilities base wide. He effortlessly processed 4.5K  
4 direct scheduled work orders valued at \$5M; increased longevity of base  
5 facilities. He superbly managed the digging permit program; which resulted  
6 in zero project delays experienced for 50+ in-house/contracted tasking. He  
7 ensured shop cooperation for repair of 20+ power outages and water breaks;  
8 which minimized down time to base; and

9       **WHEREAS**, SSgt Adriano managed \$620,000 in wireless  
10 communication assets; created inventory process and assisted in LMR  
11 upgrade and migration created squadron network security posture boosted  
12 30%. He diagnosed a system problem with civil engineer radio feeder;  
13 initiated immediate repairs resulted in no communication downtime. He  
14 oversaw/processed over 2,000 work requests monthly; swift project execution  
15 reduced approval process by 50%. He diligently monitored EOY labor  
16 summary file for cost accounting variations; ensured historical data error-free.  
17 He organized weekly schedulers meeting for 36<sup>th</sup> Civil Engineer provided  
18 leaders with real-time view of over 700 work orders. He established new  
19 tracking system for AF Form 332 inputs; ensured positive control of work

1 order packages. He scrubbed 400 work orders and closed outdated work  
2 requests; which reduced backlog by 50% and saved 250 man hours in 12  
3 shops. He inventoried five Damage Control Center (DCC) ADPE  
4 systems/two deployment kits; ensured 100% accuracy. He is an outstanding  
5 scholar; actively pursued CCAF in Operations Management through  
6 University of Maryland; accrued a total of 61 credit hours with a 3.7 GPA. He  
7 was recognized by supervisor/leadership for his outstanding performance  
8 and awarded the " Airman of the Quarter" for October – December 2005; and

9       **WHEREAS**, SSgt Adriano meticulously prepared shop safety/training  
10 logs for Unit Compliance Inspection; vital to the squadron's " Excellent"  
11 rating. His efforts aided in capturing the Pacific Air Forces' Out standing  
12 Civil Engineer Unit, small unit category two times in a row. His skillful  
13 planning and control of work order projects led to 36 CES "Best CE Small  
14 Unit" in PACAF for 2005 and 2006; now therefore, be it

15       **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'be nte Nuebi Na*  
16 *Lihselaturan Guahan* does hereby on behalf of the people of Guam commend  
17 and express deep gratitude to Staff Sergeant Don G. Adriano, United States  
18 Air Force, for his many contributions to the people of Guam, we salute him  
19 for outstanding duty and particularly in his efforts to promote better

1 relationship between the Air force and the people of Guam, and does wish  
2 Sergeant Adriano continued success in his military career; and be it further.
